From now onwards we would like you to always write, `don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box EVEN IF HE IS A LEVEL TWELVE STAR, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM as during the transfers we have no way of knowing whether a player has become level twelev in THAT SESSION.!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item. However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

LSO, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems.

Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!



PPS on him to RESTORE his fitness. However, in doing this he loses a further TWO performance levels, so you have to be really sure that he is worth resting that's for sure as it is quite an expensive process. Remember also that if this is to a star player then unless he is level 14 and above he will also lose that coveted star status as well.

Still, the all-season injury is a rare one indeed and you'?will probably rarely have one hit your team, will you?? And of course every now and again something appears in an auction to allow the restoration of an all-season injury as well. So cash can be sued, but can you wait and hope??

SCOUTING - of future opponents is early something you ought to do, unless your team is so good that it can ignore the opposition!!! The information gained from scouting allows you to set up your team and tactics to take account of their weaknesses and strengths, or if they are that much better than you to perhaps take a chance on some aspect of your play or perhaps pull up the drawbridge and hold on and hope. Knowing something about your opponents is imperative if you are to be successful, and although you can glean information from the newsletters, that is of sure, about your opponents, the scouting report really furnishes you with the information that allows you to flesh out the bones of opposing teams.

Remember though to scout the correct teams and that in general it isn't'? free at all. That is unless you have a superscout which gives you two free scouts per session. These tend to only appear through auctions and if you are an international manager of some repute. There is nothing more galling than scouting the wrong team, especially as you have to pay the scouting costs as the poor fellow has gone to the wrong ground, incurred his expenses and travelling costs. READ THE FIXTURE LIST PROPERLY, it's always the next session that you are looking at for scouting.

Though it only concerns a minority also please remember that you CAN scout Euro games. Something that few do, and ought to when you are pitting your wit against the best in the business???

Remember as well that you can also scout individual players. This has been little sued in the past but an increasing number of you are realising that it is quite important. Knowing what position and level, etc., that a player is who is constantly figuring in the newsletter as an important player, is important. If he's a level 12 MF and not a level 12 MF?A/D, then this would obviously affect how you viewed him and the necessity, say, of marking him. If he's a level 12 WG and not a LV 12 FW then you'd have to think twice about playing offside wouldn't you?? Scouting individual players is free and fleshes out the information that is gleaned from the newsletter. Ok, the latter might suffice at times, but there's always hat player who doesn't appear in the internationals squads or who the newsletter-writer persistently refuses to tell you just what his position early is, isn't there? So scout the boy.

Finally, tactical ploys and extra info. This is important for marking. If you can get the marking numbers of the opposing team then you can use that level 15 exceptional marker to destroy his midfield specialist - or so you hope. If the scouted side has more in tactical ploys that session (it is not cumulative), than the scouting side puts into extra info, then the scouting side do not get the numbers and cannot mark Marking is important, you can reduce the playing strengths of an opponents drastically by efficient marking and more than once a superior side is beaten because his better players have been marked out of the game. However, it always helps to actually read the newsletter section regarding marking to see how it is worked out as marking with lower level players than the marked ones often backfires, while the marking player has to be of a certain ability. If he is not an exceptional marker (noted on your squad sheets), and keeps failing then ignore him for future use as his marking level is obviously low. Best to mark with known exceptional markers, or attempt to perhaps improve a player who isn't exceptional up to exceptional standard by using him to mark a definitely lower level opponent. This will raise his level gradually (marking that is). Remember that failure to mark reduces his marking ability, successful marking raises it.
