



## CLEAR AT THE TOP

The title race took a turn in the favour of **Netherton FC** this week as the top two, tied on 39 points going into this round of matches, had rather differing fortunes.

The Carrot Crunchers of Netherton travelled to the Brewmaster Bowl to take on Ashcroft's **Bugman Rangers**, in a much anticipated match. It was not that long ago that Bugman were leading the way at the top, but they have drifted off the pace in recent weeks, and that was certainly the case today. In truth, it was a fairly even contest, both teams packing the midfield and with a whole string of box to box midfielders on show, the near 67,000 crowd were looking forward to an exciting contest. However, sadly for Bugman, CENTAUR in goal was something of the weak link today, conceding four goals. Top scorer MURPHY led the way, sidefooting home a QUAQGOV cross after just 15 minutes. It got worse for the home side ten minutes later when DRIPUNKT PADICH lashed home from close range after a bit of a scramble in the box. 2-0 down Bugman came back at Netherton, but visiting keeper ARRABIATTA was in fine form, stopping everything that came his way. POMPA SAULINO and FEDERER, a screamer from fully 30 yards out, added two more in the second half to leave the scoreline a convincing 4-0 win for Netherton, and Ashcroft scratching his head. It was a good performance from Bugman, just better from Smith's boys.

Meanwhile, the Netherton fans were also listening out for news from the Thommo Hole where **Thomoslavia Utd** were playing **Dore Utd**, their main title rivals. Tomoslavia were missing a number of players through injury, notably key man in the middle of the park DAVOS LECHERIOU, but this didn't stop them from grinding out a valuable 1-0 victory. How costly might this prove for Lawton and his Dore team? In truth, either team could have won it, Dore probably should have won it, but they found keeper SHERISSON in sparkling form, hands, feet, head stopping the shots that were fired in at him. At the other end, young midfielder MILLECAMPS found himself in space on 55 minutes, and delicately lobbed the ball over GAZEEDAS, much to manager Thompson's delight. The capacity crowd were ecstatic, and the news filtered through to Netherton's fans, just moments before POMPA SAULINO had knocked in their third goal - a double celebration indeed. So, Netherton edge three points clear at the top of the table, but there is still a long way to go. How crucial might their final session matchup be in this title race?

## PROMOTION PUSH IN PLACE?

While the championship in the second division seems pretty certain already, and the engravers have already started putting **Dumnonia's** name on the trophy, the race behind them is hotting up nicely. Yorkshire Rams seem fairly safe in second, and their 4-0 win over Kirkdean this week has certainly gone some way to cementing them in that place.

However, it is behind them that things start to get really interesting. **FC United Boys** are still there in third, although a home derby defeat to Cranners **Limetrees Utd** would not have been part of their managers plans. Both teams were well up for this one, but it seemed that Limetrees players were always first to the loose ball, first in the tackle and just slightly quicker all across the pitch. They managed to stifle the home side to just one meaningful chance all match, leading to increasing frustrations from the Equalizers. It was a bad foul and

booking for SCUTICEZEN that led to the first goal, PIZZA firing in the free kick from 25 yards out. From then on, Limetrees put a stranglehold on the match, GOBLIN doubling the lead late on, crashing home a stunning header to secure all three points. Too late really for Limetrees themselves, but damage done to one push for promotion. **Glasgow Celtic too**, in 4th were struggling at home, ending up on the wrong end of a 7-1 scoreline against champions-elect Dumnonia.

Now hot on their tails are **Anfield Rovers**, who did themselves the power of good this week, crushing poor **Uranium Youth** 5-0. Anfield were nervous coming into this one, with young VOGTLANDER between the sticks, protected by sweeper RICARAS and a slightly defensive looking lineup. However, once the match was underway, all nerves were gone, helped by a swift double just before the twenty minute mark. First LEHMANN and then SNITCH finding the back of the net to settle those nerves. Uranium just could not get

into it, and Rovers piled on the pressure in the second half, three more goals, including a second from SNITCH, saw them romping home, to close the gap on Glasgow Celtic to just one point. Game on!

## ONLY THREE FROM FOUR CAN GO UP

Division three also sees a tight run-in for a number of clubs, some of which may be unsettled by managerial change over coming weeks. **Margate Beach** continue to lead the way, putting **Colour Athletic** well and truly to the sword this week. Margate are clearly a cut above, and especially coming up against a team who lined up in an attacking formation, but who were told to funnel back in front of goal whenever they could. Manager Stevens plans were in tatters after just five minutes, by which time Margate were already 2-1 up, goals from LEFUOL and COPERNICUS putting them well on top, while BOLLES struck for the Athletic. However, just after half-time, Margate stretched their lead, three more goals putting the game to bed.

**AFC Lowfields** continue to follow just behind them, grateful to CONNAR's 12th minute strike for giving them the three points against a stubborn **Crewe Alexandra** who refused to lie down. The team in third are **Crimson Kings** who notched up a fine 2-0 win over **Norwood Eagles**, BREXIT TUSK and BAROTELLI giving them the points, slightly against the run of play in that one. However, manager Mansell of **Marx Men** who are in 4th, may well have picked up on the news trickling out of Acre Park that the Kings may have parted company with their manager. Still plenty to play for here.

## DISAPPOINTING

What promised to be a tight, exciting, title deciding match at the top of the fourth division turned out to be something of a damp squib. **Fujian Pirates**, who were the leaders of the division going into this one, were struggling to put out a full team. Having a squad affected by Covid over recent weeks, a request had been made to the KFA to have this one postponed, but that was turned down, and so the Pirates ended up with a number of reserves playing for the first team. Opponents **Rotorua Mist FC** seemingly didn't know this, and so lined up with a very defensive mindset. Manager Butler will, in hindsight, be disappointed that

they only managed to score twice, despite dominating the match throughout. It was defender CHEN S.B. who was man of the match, nodding in two identical headers from two identical corners to give them the points. Fujian drop to second, but the question must be whether they have the depth of squad to compete for promotion with just four games left.

**Broughton Villa** climb to third, edging above **Samdoria**, with a comfortable 2-0 win over **Seined United**. Broughton's talented forward line poured forward at every opportunity, while Seined's defence held fairly firm, until just after half time. That was when TOMMOVICH took advantage of a lapse in the defence and cracked home a ten yard shot much to the home fans jubilation. WALTERS made it two late on with a neat header, and Broughton are up into the promotion spot. Samdoria slipped up, unable to find a way past a resolute **Hyde Citizens defence**, manager Overli still with much to think about if he wants promotion here.

## AUCTION NOTES

From now onwards we would like you to always write, 'don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box EVEN IF HE IS A LEVEL TWELVE STAR, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM as during the transfers we have no way of knowing whether a player has become level twelve in THAT SESSION.!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

**In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item.** However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

**LSO, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems. Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!**

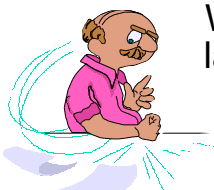

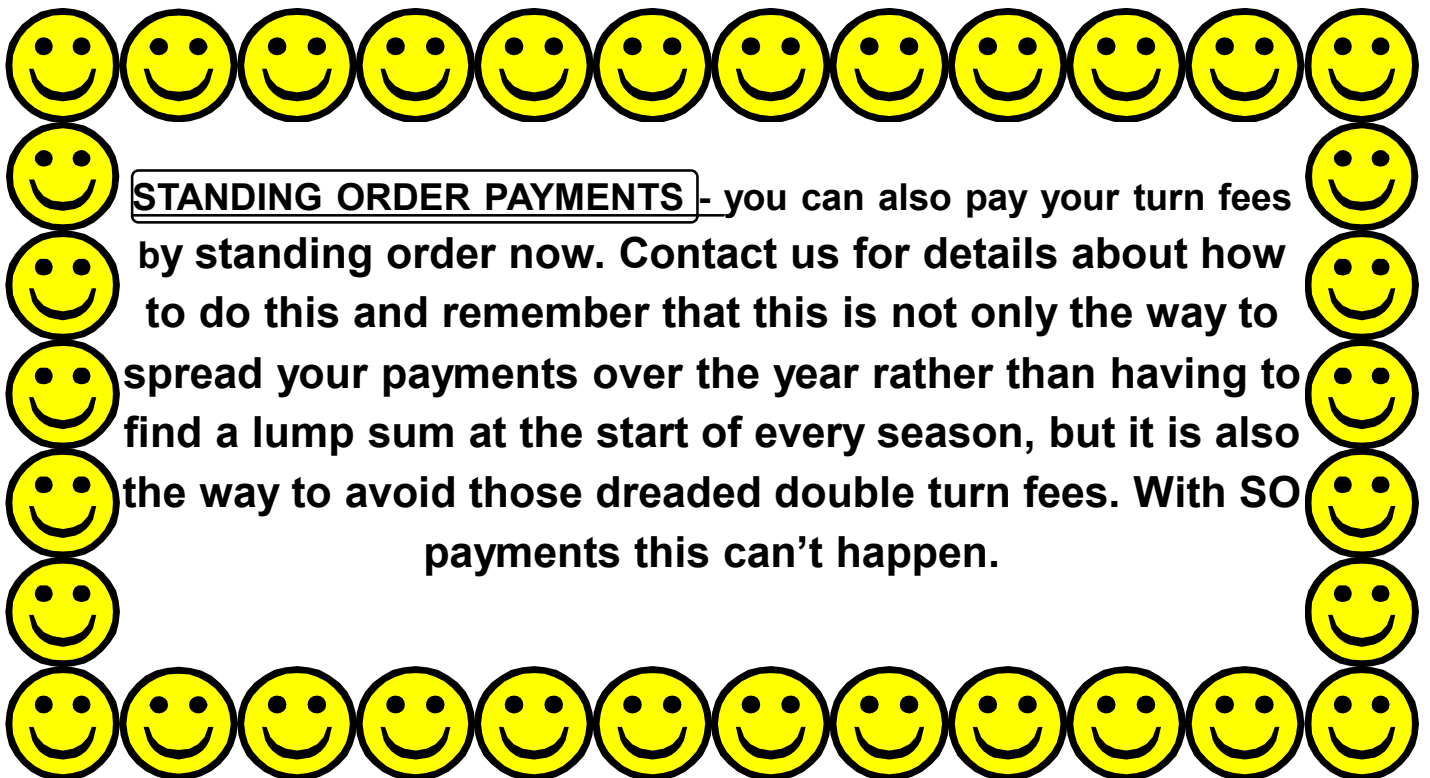

You will all notice a new stat on your turnsheets. In the space where BW/CR stats are listed there will be a X% number against all goalkeepers. This will rate your GK on his shot-saving ability and will be cumulative.

**Two points to note. It does not include penalties and own goals, but does include friendlies. And before shouting that it is wrong, remember that all shots against you are tested against the sweeper for blocking them before the GK.**

I have some ideas about how to use this stat in the future so watch this space

## KA MUSINGS & MEANDERINGS

As there are a number of leagues that will be starting a new season in the next three or four months perhaps it is time to point out the cardinal sin that often happens with a new season. That is discovering an app in your first game of the season AS A SUB and then trying to play him in the subsequent matches (this refers to teampick teams by the way). In effect if you discover somebody as a sub he doesn't actually exist and you HAVE to discover him in the normal fashion the first time you play him. If you don't get this right you incur wrong formations and NL fees, which will NOT be refunded so get it right
