



LEAGUE CUP FINAL REPLAY

BORING THEIR OPPONENTS TO SUBMISSION

Ameliehekeani 1-1 FC Sprout (AET, Ameliehekeani win 4-2 on penalties)

Once again the two teams, meeting each other for the third time in the space of two weeks, failed to produce much entertainment, but being a final it still kept both sets of fans on the edge of their seats. The midfield of **Ameliehekeani** managed to create a few chances, while **Laissez** did get some openings from their back players going forward, but neither goalkeeper looked in danger of conceding in ordinary time.

A bit more action in extra-time, and when **Bryan Adams** clumsily brought down **Purcell** in front of goal after a corner, **Turcu Merxc** stepped up and confidently sent the goalie the wrong way while placing the ball low down to the right. **The Fairies** fans must have thought this would give them the win, and that the players had learned from letting the lead slip away last time out, but no. Straight from the restart **Ameliehekeani** went forward with purpose, for once in the match, and **De Vries** found space down the left flank and got a cross in over the defenders and to, who else than the villain himself, **Bryan Adams**, at the far post, and he only had to side foot the ball into the net, with **Cajtoft** stranded at the near post anticipating a shot from **De Vries**, and with **Catalin** nowhere to be seen. This immediate response once again drained all belief from the **Laissez** players, and it was no surprise that the match ended in 1-1, and with **Ameliehekeani** taking their penalties with ease, while the **Laissez** players still looked out of ways, and only managed to get two penalties converted, with **Turku Merxc** not longer looking confident at all.

AND THEN THERE WERE TWO

Or at least probably so, although **Ameliehekeani** in theory still can catch up with **Putney**, and also overtake **Skelmersdale**. This weeks draw at **Ameliehekeani**, where the hosts and **Laissez** rehearsed their league cup final replay, in a match of little action, and not surprisingly a 0-0 draw, despite **Laissez** having slightly the better of what little chances there were.

That result meant both **Putney** and **Skelmersdale** could put some space between themselves and the two others, and this they did, and especially **Putney**, as they trashed **Red Star** 6-0, despite the hosts having to play without the injured **Montreaux**, and thus fielded an untried youngster at the back. He had nothing to do though, as the visitors came in a very defensive 4-4-2, with a disastrously failing offside tactic to go with that, as the four men was overwhelmed against the five men in the middle for the hosts, leaving **Zubizarreta** overworked between the sticks. At **Skelmersdale** the hosts also were in total control, but they could only manage a narrow 2-1 despite their dominance. Still, the three points kept them the one point ahead of **Putney**, and opened up a small gap of three points down to **Laissez**.

With **Dow Crag Rovers** trashing **St Johns** 4-0, they in reality secured their survival, as they have far the better goal difference compared to that off **Red Star** and **Tudor**, and now are six points ahead with the final two matches of the season to go.

Ameliehekeani got another 0-0 draw in their second match of the week, but might feel they should have won here, as they had much the better of chances against their too defensive visitors, **D.D.T.**, but failed to find a way past the duo of **Friedel-**

Craft and **Othmar Zeidler** at the back for the visitors. Only two points this week for **Ameliehekeani**, after meeting two tricky opponents, and now only theoretically chances left for gaining the championship. Not going any better for **Laissez-Faire**, as despite having all the play in their match at **Wycombe**, they had to fight back to just get a single point in a 1-1 draw, after giving away a penalty in the 71st minute. Apart from the penalty the hosts didn't have a single goal bound shot in the whole match, but again the **Laissez** management must question their tactics, as they saw their team give away the initiative and fail to win a match they dominated.

With **Putney** winning 5-3 at **Walton**, after being 0-2 down at half time, and with **Skelmersdale** getting a point at **Red Star**, there is no longer hope for **Laissez**, and in reality it is now a two horse race between the top two. **Red Star** restored some pride in their second match, after that dreadful result at **Putney**, holding **Skelmersdale** to a 0-0 draw, and they actually did have the better of play here, and with some luck could have won the match. There were some amongst the away fans that murmured about money changing hands before the big loss at **Putney**, and on this showing one can understand their thinking.

With their point at **Tudor**, it is now clear that **Dow** do survive, while **Red Star** and **Tudor** are going down.

AZALEA ROTTING AWAY

As mentioned last week, the management at **Azalea** seem to have gotten cold feet, and decided against a promotion, as after this weeks results it can be no doubt about that. In their first match, at home to middle of the table **Sporting Stars**, they managed to field at team even any non-league team



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would have beaten with ease. The visitors seemed to think their hosts would put up a better effort, as they played in a very defence minded SW-4-3-2, but even with all men behind the ball at all times, they managed to muster over thirty chances against their lacklustre opposition, and the win should really have been into to digits. **Azalea** then followed this up playing a similar match away at **Q of N**, with their hosts, even in their rather defensive SW-3-4-1, creating chances in a similar fashion to **Sporting Stars** in the first match. The really big shock in this match was how **Q of N** managed to let in twice, once from the only chance **Azalea** created, and once from an own goal, when **Vuelta** managed to hit a too hard backpass into his own net. This win brings **Q of N** up into 3rd place, so seems like mission accomplished for **Azalea**.

West London see their lead cut from four to two points, as **The Showboats** manage two wins as opposed to a win and a draw for the leaders, but as the leaders play one of the already relegated teams in their final match, I reckon they will retain their lead on the final day of the season. Both **Sporting Stars** and **Zion Gardens** managed to get two wins, and thus **Kirkwood** and **Walsall** are both doomed.

Sporting Stars followed up their gifted win at **Azalea**, with a hard fought win at home to fellow strugglers **Walsall**. After taking an early lead, in the 6th minute, the hosts managed to keep it tight at the back, and the visitors were not helped one bit by **Clady** getting himself sent off for a stupid and reckless two footed tackle on **Curtis**. In their first match **Walsall** had given themselves hope of survival, with a fine point at home to top half of the table **Royal Spurs**, but are now down and buried. ***** **Zion Gardens** managed to get a 1-0 win at home to **Arsenal 1866**, slightly against the play. They then struggled to see off bottom team **System Lords** in their second match, but managed to hold on to a well deserved 2-1 win, to pull them well out of their relegation worries. ***** **Kirkwood** on the other hand had a bad week, and follow **Walsall** and the **Lords** down. In their first match they got trashed at the leaders, and this was followed up with a rather lucky point at home to **Faarevejle Utd**, in a match were the visitors had the better of play.

A win here for **Balderton** will at least give them hope of staying up, but with **Hatchend Heroes** playing at bottom team **Crosspit**, it might not be enough to keep them up, if they can't pull off a very big win. For **Univ. Nanterre** a win at **Balderton** will more or less secure the divisional championship, as **Terra Firma** then will have to get a very big win in their match at home to **Lang**

Gah. Should **Univ. Nanterre** not win, then **Terra Firma** will go above them as long as they win their match, and should **Balderton** beat **Univ. Nanterre**, well, then a draw will be good enough for **Terra**. In the fight for 3rd none of this matters, but **Southdown** will have to win their match at **Sky Blue Fire** to be sure of holding on to their promotion spot, as **Bolton** have a match at home to **Barnet** on the final day, and it would take a brave man to bet against a **Bolton** win in that match. Still, one would also have said that before this week's match at **Beruit**, and somehow they managed to loose that, as the hosts scored early on, from their only chance, and then defended heroically to keep that lead. **Bolton Tigers** did much better in their second match of the week, as they were well in control at home to the leaders, and they should have won far more convincing than the 1-0 win they got. If they put on that kind of performance against **Barnet**, then **Southdown** do have to win their match to stay ahead.

This week **Southdown** started with a hard fought win at home to local rivals **Balderton**, laying the ground for the teams now going in different directions come seasons end. Their 3-3-4 had just slightly the better of play against the 3-5-2 of **Balderton**, but got a better grip on proceedings after **Zen** saw red after seemingly trying to cut **Morten Bo-Jens'** leg in two, with a horrendous tackle, as the match approached the hour mark. Still the hosts had to wait until the 85th minute before they finally got their winner. In their second match they hosted bottom team **Crosspit**, but the visitors showed great spirit, and had they played like this earlier in the season, they would surely not been rock bottom. AUCTION NOTES

From now onwards we would like you to always write, 'don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box EVEN IF HE IS A LEVEL TWELVE STAR, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM as during the transfers we have no way of knowing whether a player has become level twelve in THAT SESSION.!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item. However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

LSO, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems. Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!

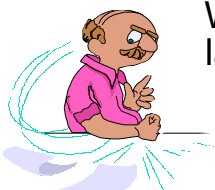

MARKING UPDATE

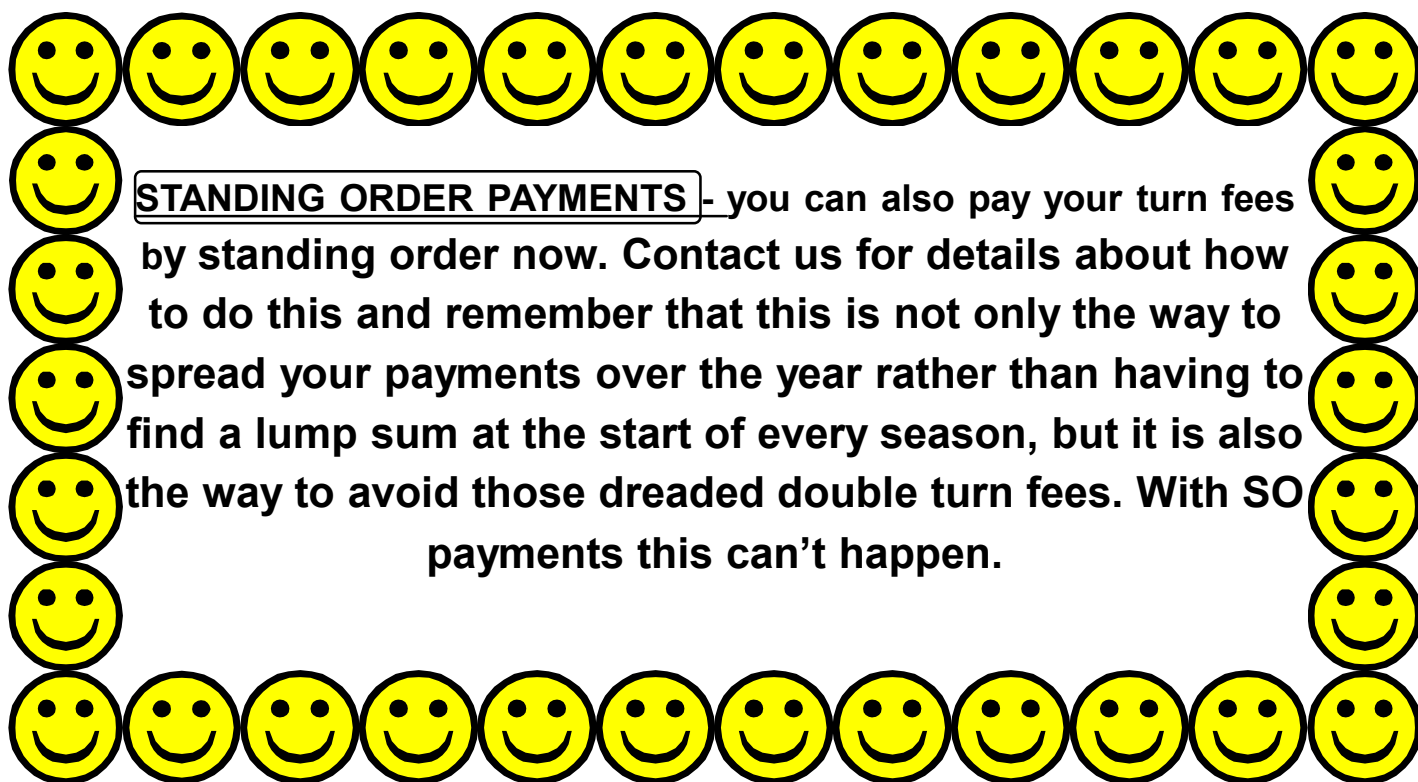

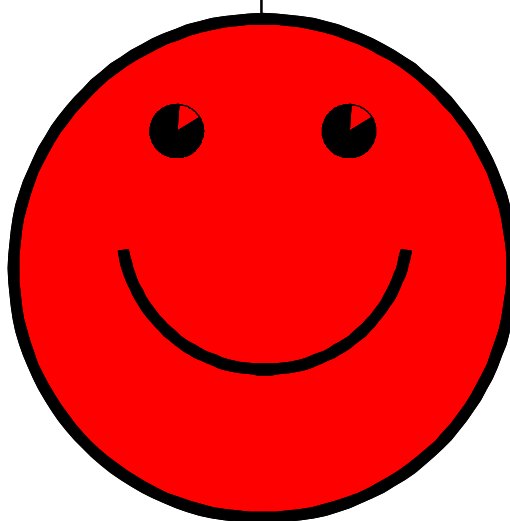
