Well here we are, another League season of the Nelson is upon us as the dark nights draw in and before we know it Santa will be emptying his sack over for all those who have been good this year. Superb start to the new season by Steadders courtesy of a 3-0 away win at **Wembley** and a 4-0 victory at home against derby rivals **Furze Hill** that will have made other managers in the Division sit up and take notice. Happy days. The exiled Englander in Glasgow also got off to a great start as **Rhuddlan** recorded back to back victories over Belfast boys Colly and Seamy who consoled each other in the pub a few days later "feck it, fancy losing to that stupid fanny". Three sides start the new campaign with a win and a draw with Fingers, Brutus and Daggins all poised ready for the top two to slip up over the months ahead. Looking at the **Recwand** squad they definitely look good enough for a tilt at the title this campaign. How **Hornchurch** have started so well is more of a mystery with Brutus' side looking a shadow of their former selves. Creative shenanigans going on here I think. Daggins is busy reshaping his squad for the season ahead so discount him at your peril once the rebuild settles down. My own personal tip for the title are **Camlann** whose boss Read has finally sorted out the GK position and with a talented midfield anything other than promotion will surely be seen as a disaster. Comfortable victories over **Martian Maniacs** and promoted **Premier** were achieved without moving out of 2nd gear to suggest they are ready for the expected promotion push. Jack Smith and Grandpa KP also started the season in style with narrow but impressive looking wins over both **Viking Lords** and **Preston**. The win over **Preston** was particularly impressive with Disco Dave's side containing three excellent midfielders who would easily fit into any side in the top flight.

As for the early strugglers it's a bit of surprise to see **Viking Lords** with nothing to show from their opening two games but, like a number of sides, rejuvenation wasn't kind. There are weaker sides in the Division so I don't expect Llanberis' slimmer of the year to stay near the bottom. **Southend Seas** also look to be in a false position and Deadly Dag will no doubt be reading the riot act to get a response from his players so they start to pick up the wins required to bring the best out of key man Vasquez. With four unmanaged teams in Division 4 there's never been a better time for the managers in this Division to get their side ready for a promotion push. Dave Hails has been rebuilding **Chelsea Cons** for what feels like a decade (3 seasons) and

Jorgensen has renamed his side **FC New City** in the hope it brings them better fortunes and 3-1 home win over **Aboukiri** and a 0-0 draw against **Royal Wadds** (which they really should have won) would indicate it's working so far. **Temasik Lions** also start with a win and a draw and I expect Barney to lead his side to promotion this season. One high level midfield specialist, a first team full of P/S players and they are easily the richest side in the League so the cash is ready spend ready whenever the right players come along to strengthen the side. Dag's **Mega-City** are the last of the managed clubs on four points. A hard fought 0-0 draw against **Bradfield** and a 1-0 win at **Thunderbirds** proved they can grind out results even when not firing on all cylinders. They will certainly keep opposition clubs physios busy with their enthusiastic approach to each game.

At the bottom **Thunderbirds** slipped to two 1-0 defeats and a nasty injury to Virgil to boot. It looks like it's going to be a long old season for Hudson at **Rainham** now that he is able to return to the managerial hot seat after illness. Hopefully the Dumpster hasn't made too much of a mess of them and they can soon be turned around.

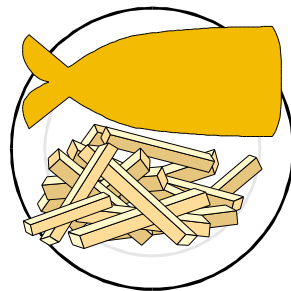

Please note that from now onwards it is illegal to sell any player and then buy him back in the next three session FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER. If you do that player will be banned for life and you will lose him

AUCTION NOTES

From now onwards we would like you to always write, `don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box EVEN IF HE IS A LEVEL TWELVE STAR, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM as during the transfers we have no way of knowing whether a player has become level twelve in THAT SESSION.!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item. However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

LSO, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems. Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!

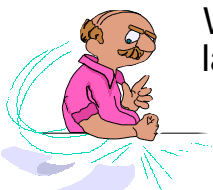

MARKING UPDATE

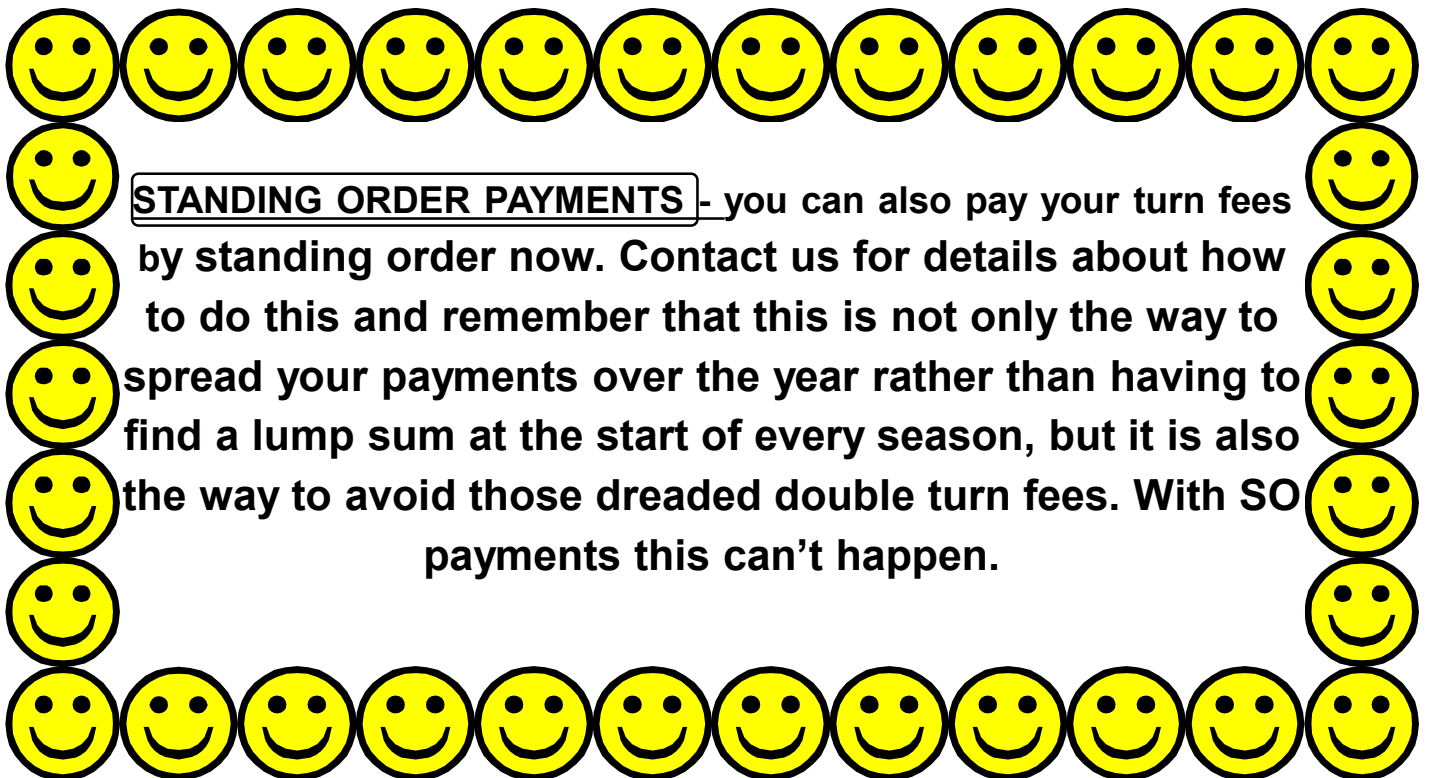

You will all notice a new stat on your turnsheets. In the space where BW/CR stats are listed there will be a X% number against all goalkeepers. This will rate your GK on his shot-saving ability and will be cumulative.

Two points to note. It does not include penalties and own goals, but does include friendlies. And before shouting that it is wrong, remember that all shots against you are tested against the sweeper for blocking them before the GK.

I have some ideas about how to use this stat in the future so watch this space

MUTTERINGS AND MEANDERINGS OF THE KA MIND

Just a reminder this time. As you all know you can only have five players in any of the three main outfield areas. This has an effect on any specialist players that you might have who normally add their levels to another outfield area. So if you have five players then the amount that your specialist adds to that area is always halved. This is often forgotten by managers expecting more from their MF specialists in important areas.
