



SAINTLY INTERVENTION

Could this be the year that **Sprout** are finally knocked off the top? **Botafogo** came close last season and this year it very much looks like it's **Saints** who have taken up the challenger's mantle. They travelled to **Sofia** for a game that, on paper at least, looked like a shoo-in for the visitors but it was anything but and **Saints** have to count themselves very fortunate indeed to come away with all 3 points.

A game of few chances and perhaps manager MANSELL, nervous of having GEMMILL out injured, went out with too a too defensive mindset which certainly hampered his team's ability going forward. Opponents **Sofia**, aware of the **Saints** firepower, also kept things tight with a zonal marking system that ensured **Saints** struggled to find space but couldn't manage to make much headway themselves against a stubborn **Saints** rear guard, the net result of which was an equal amount of chances were created by both sides and the difference ultimately came down to goalkeepers, with YARLOVO of the home side having a complete shocker.

To be fair, there wasn't much he could do for the first one as midfielder ST DAVID, perhaps frustrated with his side's lack of penetration, hits a stunner from outside the box straight into the top corner. **Saints** then make it safe with 9 minutes to go, adding a second from a cross that left YARLOVO flapping at thin air to let DE STROY head home with the simplest of finishes at the back post. In contrast, the chances that **Saints** 'keeper RA had to deal with, he dealt with them comfortably and never looked threatened in all honesty.

A lucky win though when all is said and done for **Saints** as **Sofia** were well worth the draw but a bit of luck is required at times and can be the difference sometimes between first and second?

Elsewhere, a cracking result for **AS Centurions** against a shell-shocked **Paradisio** who just seemed off the pace out there today. Even the forced inclusion of youngster O'HARA at the back couldn't be the sole reason that **Paradisio** were so comprehensively beaten.

Both teams lined up with similar formations but that's where the similarities ended as **Centurions** dominated this one from the off, opening the scoring after just 2 minutes as forward WRESTLING runs on to a through ball to calmly slot his finish home. His strike partner DRAMQVUIST then gets in on the action to make it 2 after 13 minutes played and it was literally all 1 way traffic from there with **Paradisio** only managing one shot on target all game, a tame effort from LUVANA easily dealt with by 'keeper ROYSTON.

A 3rd goal, DRAMQVUIST's second half way through the first-half effectively killed the game and some of the away fans could be seen leaving already to start the long trip home. Misery was piled on to misery as **Centurions** continued the second half in the same vein as the first. Midfielder LITVENENKO makes it 4 within a few minutes of the restart before WRESTLING also gets his second on 51 minutes, flicking in a header from close range and the away section really started emptying rapidly.

A 6th, this time from defender KHALI who had come up for a corner, rounds off a stunning display for **Centurions** and the result could have been much worse for the visitors as there was still half an hour to play at this point but there were no more goals forthcoming and the game ends 6-0.

INTER WALLS FALL DOWN

A stunning game between one of the favourites **Inter Walls** and **New Caledonia** gave us a 7 goal thriller. Despite the sidelining of midfield maestro TARDELLI through injury, **Walls** manager SAMSON must have still fancied his chances against a side that has only managed 1 point so far this season and were struggling to get going but **Caledonia** showed today what they are possibly capable of as they matched the visiting opposition easily.

An opening goal in the 13th minute must have settled any nerves SAMSON had as INTENSE opens the scoring for the visitors but **Caledonia** responded strongly and were soon level through a crashing header from midfielder MICH.

This goal seemed to open up some belief from the home side as they started to get on top and they deservedly took the lead as COHEN was left unmarked in the box to nod home a header to make it 2-1 but **Inter Walls** always looked threatening and not only

equalised on the 37th minute but restored their lead with scant minutes of the half remaining to make it 3-2 in their favour.

Unbelievably, **Caledonia** pull 1 back just a minute later to level the scores as **PRIEST** pops up to crash the ball home from 10 yards out, giving 'keeper **GERIENT** no hope and it was all set up for the second half with the win there for the taking by either side.

A frantic second half ensued as both teams looked for the winner but poor finishing saw some golden opportunities for both sides wasted and, as time ticked on, it looked more and more likely that a draw was on the cards here despite the continued efforts of both teams to find a winner.

That all changed on the hour mark though as once again that man **PRIEST** shows his worth. This time he hits an unstoppable 30 yard drive that slams in to the bottom corner to give **Caledonia** a precious lead. **Inter Walls** immediately step it up a gear in an attempt to find an equaliser and at times they were camped in the opposition half as **Caledonia** desperately held out and have 'keeper **DEV** to thank in no small part as he saved his side on more than one occasion. Try as they might though, **Walls** just couldn't find that goal and the game ends 4-3 in **Caledonia's** favour.

A great win for the home side and maybe something that they can possibly build on while I feel that **Inter Walls** will chalk this one up to experience and, especially with the return of **TARDELLI**, I am expecting to see a backlash to this result.

Another somewhat unexpected result in a session which to be fair had quite a few was the **St Helen's** victory over red hot favourites **Sunderland**. Both these teams had been tipped to do well this season so this was always going to be an encounter full of promise and it certainly didn't disappoint.

Town manager **ASHCROFT**, travelling away and knowing just how dangerous his opponents can be, opted for a defensively-minded game plan which worked perfectly today and always allowed his side a foothold in the game and it was **Town** who took the lead in the 11th minute, albeit very briefly, as midfielder **PISZCZEK** gets forward to side foot the ball home.

However, lack of concentration from **Town** straight from the re-start allows **Sunderland** to move the ball in to a dangerous position and within seconds of going behind, they had equalised with a snap shot from **JORGIE**

BAST, a wake-up call for **Town** if there was ever one needed.

They respond well to the disappointment of conceding in that manner though and once again take the lead, this time through forward **WELLENSKI** who is played through brilliantly from midfield to give him a one on one with the 'keeper.

Both sides continued to play an entertaining and open style of football and the game flowed back and forth nicely as more goals were sought, **St Helen's** knowing that they would probably need another one to make the game safe while **Sunderland** probed for the equaliser and it is **St Helen's** who make the critical breakthrough, midfielder **CUNNINGHAM** racing in to the box to meet a cross with his head with twenty minutes to go.

St Helens shut up shop after this, desperate to hold on to their lead and knowing there was just 20 left on the clock while **Sunderland** surge forward looking to get something out of this game and, with just under quarter of an hour to play they pull 1 back, a stunning volley from **JENS** giving them some hope but it was not to be as **St Helens** continue to defend resolutely and, despite the pressure, **Sunderland** were finding it very difficult to find space in the last 3rd and ultimately that 3rd goal.

HENDON GOONERS GUNNING FOR THE TOP

Despite my misgivings early on in the season regarding the squad size of the **Gooners**, so far they are doing fine and if they can continue injury free while they expand their squad, they will certainly be there or thereabouts come season's end although admittedly, this week they rode their luck a little against **Burnden Villa** and it was one moment of magic that was the difference between these 2 teams.

Arguably, **Burnden** were the better side for long periods in this one but couldn't really turn that dominance in to viable goal chances, they did create a few attempts on target but were in the main, kept relatively quiet by their opposition.

Gooners on the other hand, created nothing of worth all game apart from one glorious chance which fell their way in the 22nd minute. A fine sweeping move down the left with a clever cross ball to switch the play to the right and forward **LAM** pops up at the back post to poke the cross home.

Villa continued to press all game hoping to find an equaliser but never really looked like threatening the **Gooners** goal in any real way and the game stays as it is with **Gooners** ending up taking all 3points.

A very frustrating afternoon for manager **BROOKS** indeed who will be furious to be leaving with nothing in a game that they could have perhaps won while **Gooners** now sit top of the pile in division 3 but have played a game more than their nearest rivals **Harleys Heroes**.

Edoras take another 3 points this week, this time against struggling **Hobbiton**. **Edoras** dominated this one from the off and had taken the lead as early as the 10th minute as **BURLEY** volleys home. They extend this lead just 2 minutes later when **RULMED** is allowed to run through unopposed from midfield before chipping over the 'keeper and **Hobbiton** already have a mountain to climb.

The situation is made worse from the home side's point of view as **BURLEY** claims his second just 5 minutes after that and it looks like **Edoras** just may run away with this one but they fail to score any more for the remainder of the half and the break comes with the score remaining at 3-0.

Whatever half time pep talk manager **BUTLER** gave his troops he should have perhaps given at the beginning of the game instead as **Hobbiton** come out looking a different side, tighter at the back and playing further up the pitch and within 4 minutes of the restart they had pulled one back with midfielder **STUKA** finishing from a tight angle.

Ten minutes later, **MCFADDER** adds a second as his shot goes in off the post and the comeback looked on but **Edoras** had finally woken up to the fact that they may just have a game on their hands and once more took control. Further goals from **Hobbiton** started to look increasingly unlikely while it was **Edoras** who were in the ascendancy once more and with 15 minutes to go the visitors make the game safe as **GRUBER** scores their 4th to break **Hobbiton** hearts and secure the points for **Edoras**.

SUPERNOVA SHARAPOVA

Shock result in the 4th as lowly **Sleeping Woods** pull off a fine win against **Walsall Town**. A defensive set-up from manager **BUTLER** pre-empted **Town's** blitz tactics of a 4 man front line while the extra man in midfield allowed them to pressure their opponent's 3 man

backline with the result that it was **Woods** making all the chances and looking the most likely to score and that was exactly what happened, although it did take until the 84th minute, just as every one was thinking a draw was on the cards.

To be fair, **Woods** had been on top as far as chances were concerned for most of the game although **Town** did make 1 or 2 really good opportunities, these were squandered much in the same way as their opposition's chances were and a lack of quality up front from both sides was very evident in this one but late on, it was **Woods** who conjured up one more chance and the ball fell to **SHARAPOVA**, who had had a fairly quiet game up until this point.

A flowing move the length of the pitch ends with a one-wo to put **SHARAPOVA** through on goal and he makes no mistake as, shrugging off a challenge just outside the box, he slots the ball in to the bottom left hand corner to give **Sleeping Woods** the lead with just minutes to.

Too little time for **Walsall** to make any sort of effective response means the game ends 1-0 to **Woods** and a good 3 points for them indeed.

Purley Kings move up the table this week courtesy of a good win away from home against **NLP-Redstox**. In a very even game which could have gone either way, it was **Kings** who managed to find the breakthrough.

Both sides came in to this one with a defensive mentality and the first order of the day seemed to be don't let the opposition score which translated in to a very cagey encounter with not a lot of chances created.

I would suggest that **Redstox** probably had the best of the early exchanges and may have sneaked a goal early on but the **Kings** grew in to the game the longer it went on and started to make some chances of their own and perhaps deservedly took the lead after half an hour played.

A promising move from the **Kings** looked to have broken down and as the ball was half-cleared by the **Redstox** defence in to no-man's land, it was picked up by midfielder **LASCAR** who took one touch before curling it high in to the right hand corner of the net to make it 1-0 to the away side and that's how the game stayed until half-time.

Very much the same in the second half with both sides seemingly still more intent on stopping the opposition scoring rather than scoring themselves, chances were few and far between and this one goal always looked

likely to be enough to settle it, which indeed it was as the final whistle blows with no more goals scored.

This win puts **Purley Kings** in 4th, just behind **Flowserve** on goal difference while **Redstox** slip down to 7th but there is a long way to go yet and will this still be the picture at the end of the season?

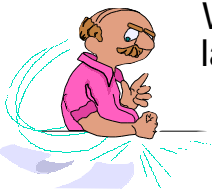

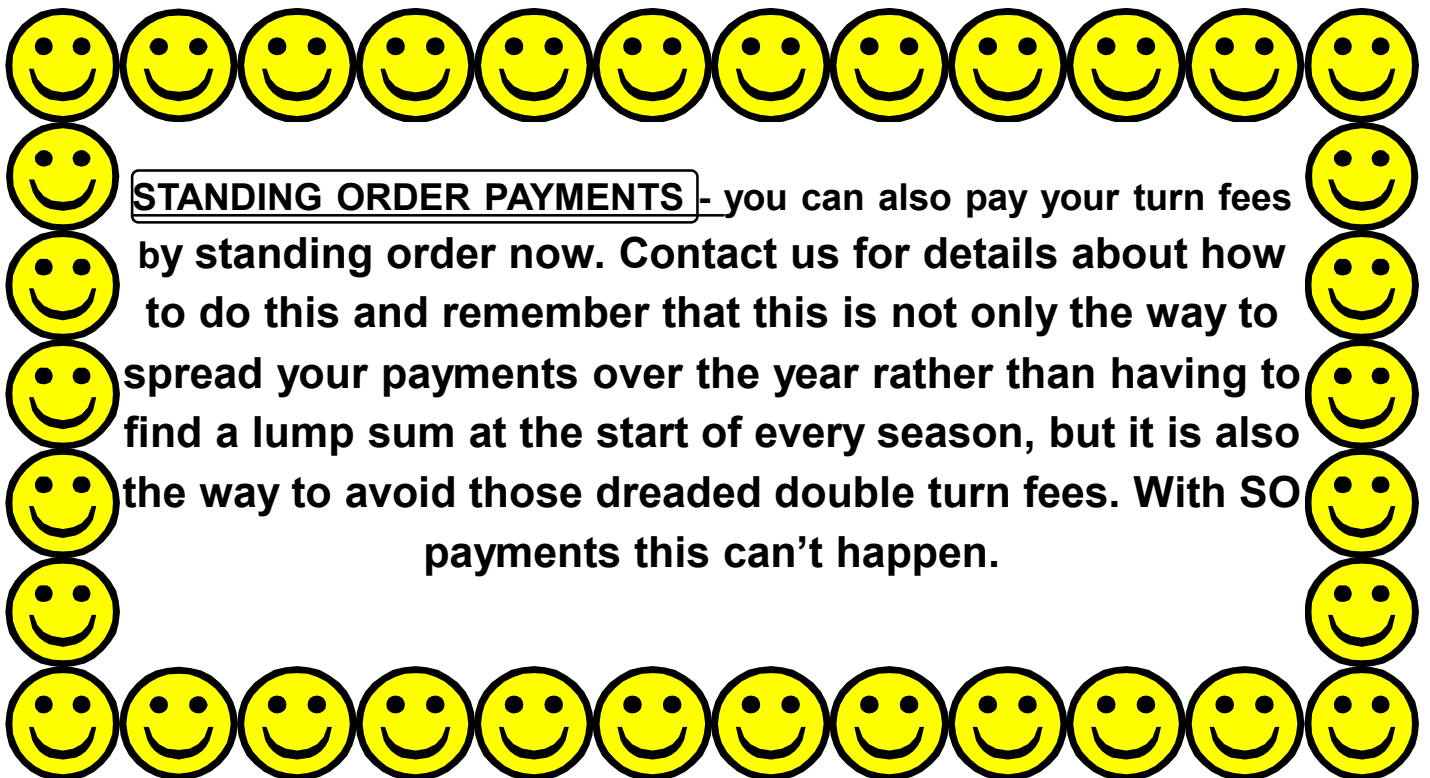

MUTERINGS AND MEANDERINGS

Time to revisit the offside rules

- 1) Cannot be played if you play a SW as a SW
- 2) Cannot be played if you play diamond
- 3) Playing offside reduces the shot chances of the opposition FWline, but you also need to have a stronger MF than them. If not you stand the chance of their midfield decimating you.
- 4) If your opponent has a WG or DFA in his team they can break down your offside trap, the higher the level of these players the more effective they are in breaking your trap.
- 5) The more players that the opponent has in their FWline the more effective (generally), the offside tap is, though many factors affect this.

Basically try not to play offside against a team with a stronger midfield than yours (in levels) no matter how strong his FWline might be. The offside tap can work well if you know your opponents team and plan accordingly BUT it can be a disaster if you don't . SCOUT and read newsletters to find out what he has

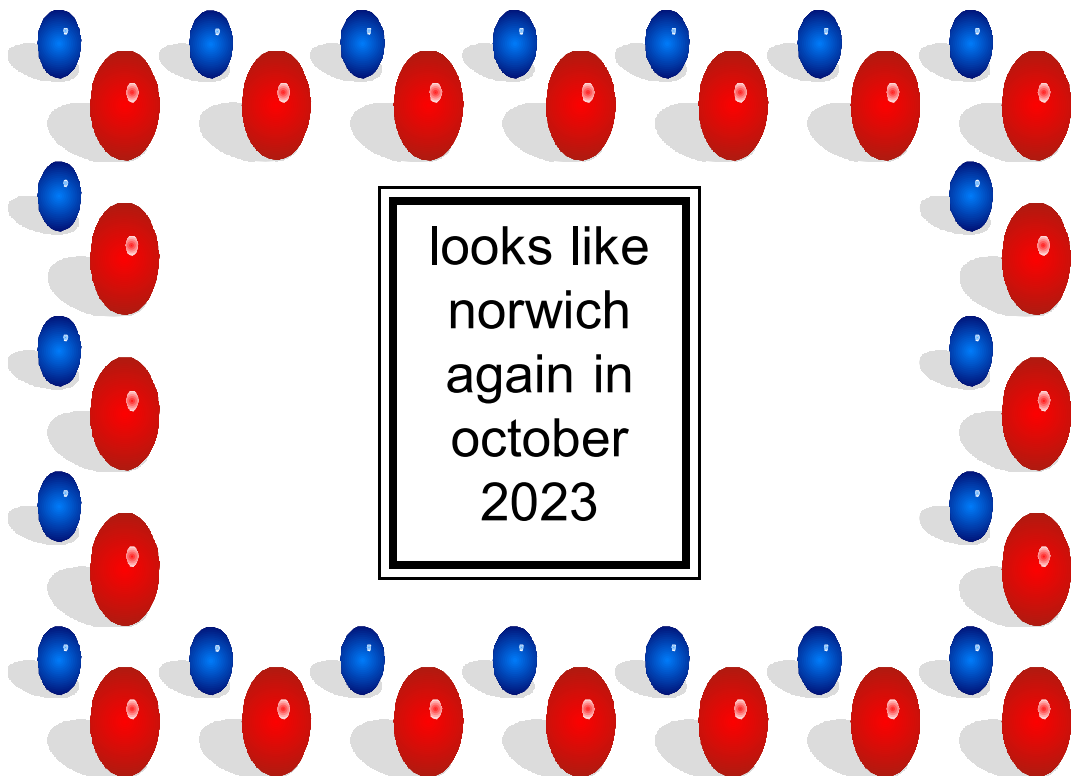

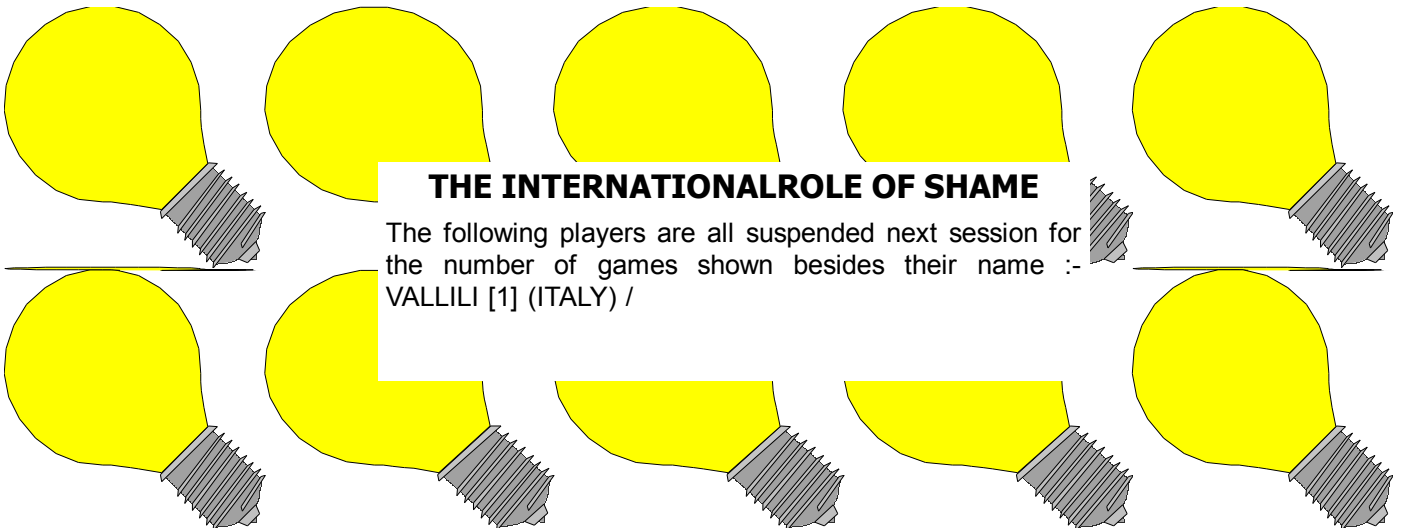

STARTING OUT TIPS

or, what do I do faced with a new team to manage!!

If you are lucky you may have a couple of million in the Bank but that won't be enough to turn things around in a couple of sessions. You need to be committed to be in this for the long haul.

Have a plan. Base your coaching on getting 2 SPS per session. If you get a few more along the way as the season progresses then great either cash them or coach an extra youth player. Aim to coach your APP's & SBY's to level 12's by seasons end. Better to have 3 17/18 yr old level 12's than 5 level 8's.

Clear out the 24-4's etc. to get them off the wage bill as they will be on relatively high wages. Either sell them to other managers at below NL price (you will still benefit vs selling to NL due to wages). If you can't get a buyer then hold on to them and run their contract down before selling to NL by session 10 _ sales to NL go to half price after that.

Play 2 APPS or a SBY every game unless you have a realistic chance of winning but try to win your derby games. Keep your MP's for derby games, matches against fellow strugglers and for (hopefully) a bit of a run in the Bowl.

Build up your cash balance. Keep building this until you have at least circa £8m. Try to pick up bargains (below NL value) from the auction so you can then sell them on at a profit.

Invest money in youth. Don't rely on this producing multiple MF specialists, unless your name is Morten. What you will hopefully get is a few FUT's which you can coach at 0.5 SP per level or sell for cash. This is a good way of increasing your teams' skill level quickly.

Choose a category for the team and aim to get all the players of the same category (P, S or P/S). Having a power team is easier to build up quickly as there are more of them, there are plenty of 95 BW's around and are cheap to buy. However, longer term you will need to change the category of them team as power teams don't become super teams.

If you have players that don't match your chosen category look to trade them for another player who is. It is rare your team will be full of P/S players so if you have any it may be best to move them on to build up your cash balance or trade for another player.

Look to get a good quality GK and SW. You may not win many matches but two level 12's at the back could bring in some extra SP's through 0-0 draws.

Don't coach anyone over the age of 18 unless there is a really good reason to do so e.g. 23-10 MF specialist.

You need a captain so you can afford one player over the age of 19 _ hopefully your captain will star or get rejuvenated.

Within 2 seasons you should have a team full of level 12's and a decent cash balance as a solid platform to start your ascent to being the next KA super team.
