



SAINTS SLIP UP

Saints had a chance this session to open up some daylight between themselves and the ever-present **FC Sprout** who only managed a point in a very evenly contested game against **AS Centurions** whose manager will be delighted with the result I am sure.

However, they faced a very tricky game against **Wycombe FC** who have done much better in the early season than initially predicted. Clever marking from **Wycombe** constrained their opponent's attacking capabilities to a large degree but the real difference out there today was the pairings of GINETTA and DE STROY for **Saints** and the service that HARZARD got from the 2 wingbacks, KOMPANY and FRISISKI in the **Wycombe** side.

GINETTA was hardly able to make any meaningful contribution and found himself pinned back for much of the game while while KOMPANY and FRISISKI were able to get forward almost at will and their link up play with HARZARD caused problems all afternoon.

Despite being on the front foot though, **Wycombe** found it difficult to get a shot past RA'S in the **Saints** goal who was having a stormer and the first half drew to a close with both sides even.

The home fans couldn't be blamed for expecting some sort of response from **Saints** in the second half but it was, sadly, never forthcoming and **Wycombe** still remained the side looking more likely to score and they finally made the breakthrough on the hour mark. GOD, being given far too much space thanks mainly to HARZARD tying up the attention of the centre halves, is fed through brilliantly by TURKAN from midfield and he unleashes a shot in to the top corner that gave RA'S no chance whatsoever.

The rest of the game petered out a little from there as **Wycombe** seemed content to hold it at 1-0, confident in the fact that they were in control of the game and just needed to keep containing their opponents which they did until the final whistle to take all 3 points.

This result sees **Sprout** head the table by just a solitary point but I think it's a brave man now who would bet on them relinquishing that position for the rest of the season.

Further down the table, **Trujillo** pull off a cracking win against **Botafogo** to see them move up to mid-table respectability. To be

fair, **Botafogo** came in to this one with a couple of injuries to some key players and a clever offside trap from their opponents further compounded their problems but the main blame for their heavy defeat lies firmly in the hands of goalkeeper ENSCONSE who had a stinker.

Under the cosh from the off, **Botafogo** conceded a number of set pieces and it was from one of these that **Trujillo** opened their account, defender CONNECTICUT nodding home from a corner. Further misery for them soon followed as midfielder DUCHCOV is allowed to turn 20 yards out and his tame side-foot shot squeezes under the prone body of ENSCONSE to make it 2 and to cap it all off, PEETERS makes it 3 in what was a dreadful 5 minute period for the away side. Poor finishing rather than any real response from **Botafogo** sees the scoreline unchanged at half time but it didn't matter as this game was effectively over as a contest by then anyway.

Two late goals from defender FULGUR, both coming again in the space of a few minutes, seals off a comprehensive victory for **Trujillo** and perhaps gives them something to build on from here.

Immortals did their first division survival chances the power of good with a slim 1-0 victory against fellow strugglers **Sofia**. Early in the season for sure but this game already felt like a 6-pointer and it was manager THOMPSON who got his tactics spot on this session.

A similar set-up from both sides but with the added difference that THOMPSON had instructed his players to drop deep saw a game with few clear cut chances created and it was a solitary goal just after the re-start that settled this one.

Immortals started the second half brightly after a goal-less first half and applied pressure to the home side's defence who failed to deal with a long punt forward. In the ensuing scramble, the ball falls at the feet of forward LOKI and his shot sneaks in to the bottom corner with unsighted goalkeeper YARLOVO unable to do anything about it.

Good defending from from the away side saw them see out the rest of the game comfortably and take all 3 points from this one.

NO JOY FOR THE BOYS

City Boys had a tough derby encounter against esteemed opponents **Sunderland FTM** this session and it was a game in which no quarter was asked or given with crunching tackles flying in from the off. The referee had lost patience with it all by the 22nd minute and **Sunderland** midfielder POPOV finds his name the first in the book after a high tacked was deemed to be so dangerous that a red card was the only option.

Boys midfielder TIGANA also finds his name recorded just a minute later as the yellow card is produced this time. These 2 bookings settled everything down somewhat and the game became more of a football match than a kicking fest from then on.

A good move from the **Boys** a few minutes later sees them awarded a penalty as tricky winger POPOV is brought down in the box only for POSSIJON to blast his spot kick miles over the bar. As if this wasn't bad enough for them, the resulting goal kick taken quickly, finds HATTIE in tons of space and he delivers a pin-point cross right on to the head of JORDIE BAST who could hardly miss!

Sunderland, although a man down, took complete control of the proceedings from then on as they pushed **City Boys** further and further back in to their own half and they could have easily extended their advantage on more than one occasion but unfortunately for them, failed to do so.

The second half continued in much the same vein and the watching fans must have wondered at times which side was the one down to 10 men such was **Sunderland's** dominance. A second goal always looked likely and was duly presented when defender HIMMLER found himself in an advanced position and allowed to run through unmarked to chase down a through ball. He made no mistake with his finish and gave **Sunderland** a deserved 2 goal lead.

This victory sees a much-changed picture at the top of the second with **City Boys** relinquishing the top spot to fall to 3rd in the table allowing **Inter Walls** to claim pole position for the time being.

Another side right up there at the moment and one that I feel will certainly be in the mix come season's end is **St Helens Town**. Playing away from home to similarly placed **Wymondham Town**, manager ASHCROFT had set up his side with a view to at least not lose this one and the defensive mind-set coupled with a zonal marking system, worked perfectly.

Having said that, it was still a very even game and the scoreline doesn't really reflect the actual match but **Wymondham** couldn't have had a worse start as they conceded an own goal with just 8 minutes played and, desperate to rectify the situation almost immediately, flood forward from the kick-off leaving themselves exposed at the

back, a situation exploited to the full by **Town** as they counter, ZEUS DEEWATER finishing the move with a towering leap to make it 2-0 inside of a minute.

Wymondham tried manfully to recover from this position and threatened to pull one back on more than one occasion but **St Helens** soaked up most of this and hit them with a sucker-punch, again catching them on the break, to make it 3-0 as midfielder MONTY DON strikes from 10 yards out, finishing off a lovely move and leaving **Wymondham** with a mountain to climb.

The second half saw them at least attempt to do this as they came out all guns blazing but they were unable to make any real headway and were once again caught out as **Town** caught them on the break just a few minutes after the re-start. A long ball sets free midfielder PIMBLETT who then lobs the 'keeper to make it 4 and you can see the fight drain out of the **Wymondham** players as this goal finally kills off all thought of a comeback.

The rest of the game was pretty pedestrian, with **Town** more than happy to sit back and defend what they had got and **Wymondham** simply going through the motions as all belief had been knocked out of them.

Big kudos to ASHCROFT for getting his tactics spot-on, although the scoreline was somewhat flattering and conversely, a cruel day for manager MOORE who would be justified in thinking they could have got something out of that game but also lots of positives to take from it as well. They just have to dust themselves off now and chalk that one down to experience and based on this performance I am sure they will have a relatively successful season.

GOONERS GUNNED DOWN

A mouth-watering top of the table clash saw **Hendon Gooners** host **Harleys Heroes** in what must be one of the most anticipated div 3 fixtures this season. Goals were definitely expected here and goals were what we got but perhaps not quite in the proportion anticipated.

Manager LAWTON had done his homework for this one and the marking of midfield players CHUN MAD and WEBER swung the odds heavily in the away side's favour. It took them just 8 minutes to open their account through forward SASKATCHEWAN and they didn't look back from there.

Constant pressure and a fairly regular peppering of the **Gooner's** goal soon produced a second as FJORDEN cracks home a loose ball to make it 2 inside of 20 minutes as the **Gooner's** tried to hang on and create something of their own but to very little avail.

A similar tale in the second half saw 2 further goals scored by **Harleys** as they kept the pressure on until the very end. The third goal came courtesy of a corner with the centre half pushed up for it and he duly nods home to make it 3. More

IFK Didi finally record their first win of the season as they give their fans something to cheer about at last with a 2-0 victory over **Sleeping Woods** in a game which I suspect manager BUTLER fancied he may win but a cruel injury to forward WALD early on threw his plans out the window and **Didi** made the most of their opponents reduced firepower.

That's not to say for a moment it was a one-sided affair as **Woods** created enough chances in the game to at least get them on the score sheet but their finishing without WALD was off today, an issue that their opponents certainly didn't suffer from.

A bright start from **Didi**, who perhaps adapted to the conditions better, certainly surprised their opponents and had them on the backfoot for much of the game and midway through the first half they are rewarded for their efforts as VAN DER VALK strikes from 10 yards out to give them the lead.

Sleeping Woods, to be fair, did mount a response to this and came in to the game more and more as it progressed, even dominating possession for long parts of the proceedings but were unable to find that 1 clear cut chance to put themselves level and paid the ultimate price for that as **Didi** increased their lead on the half-hour mark, BOGDANNO heading home.

Further chances fell to **Didi** in the second half but, thanks to some good goal-keeping from BONNER, they failed to increase their lead and, although they had to endure a frantic final few minutes as **Woods** tried desperately to get something out of the game, they held out and ended the day 2-0 victors.

A fine win for **Didi** although it didn't do much to change their league standing, it does perhaps give them something to build on and the team is starting to take shape a little bit. Meanwhile the loss of WALD for the next 6 games is going to have a huge effect on **Sleeping Woods** and will certainly curtail his options for the next couple of sessions at least.

Thor's Hammers finally do what they have tended to do so well over the last couple of seasons and score a bagful of goals at last. Never really one to worry too much about defending, manager STEVENS once again throws his troops forward and gets on the right side of the result in a rather topsy-turvy encounter against **Dragon**.

Thor's strike first with only 3 minutes on the clock as THOR latches on to a lovely through ball before calmly side-footing in to the corner. **Dragon** immediately strike back to level the proceedings as forward SAINTS bends low to finish with his head.

Thor's then grab the game by the scruff of the neck and further goals from VALERON, ICARUS and KING see them take a commanding 4-1 lead with just 5 minutes to go before the interval and everyone in the ground must have thought it was all over.

What about having a tilt at **Crewe Alexandra** in the Ramsey league? Near the bottom of the fourth they have a weak squad though no problem in the age department as two stars apart most of their squad are 19YO. A top rank keeper performs miracles for them. Best though this is a team to work with as they have almost 10 million in the bank. Free season here for the hot dog who takes them on?

CONTRACTS UPDATE

We have listened to the moaners who in contract negotiations have lost very good players cos they cannot get them to agree to a new contract. Galling to see their prized possession in the expired section of the autumn. Ok you will no doubt get some recompense for him, but the reserve bid is always painfully low and you never never know who might snaffle his arse with a cheeky bid do you.

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **DF/A X 2 /**

UT/WG/FWS x1.5 / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

We suggest that you always add 1K to your bids

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third of his basic wage

- so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K -
