

## **QUADRUPLE STILL ON FOR UPTON PARK?**

Upton Park continue to destroy all in their wake as they edge ever closer to what could be an incredible quadruple. Neither Pcats Avengers or Sunny Park had any answer to Upton Park's attacking prowess despite dirty Danny & Dag playing very aggressively and hyping up their goalies in a rather predictable and unsporting fashion. Both teams were dispatched for five goals as Barrett's men march on. Perhaps the pressure is starting to mount for Inter East Ham, who saw off FFH Allstars easily enough but then suffered a last minute meltdown at home to Shady Vale, costing them the 3 points. Shady Vale have some fine ball winners in their side and they stopped the usual creative onslaught from Inter and hung in the game until the end, when Madsen poked home from a goalmouth scramble to leave Lawton bemoaning his luck yet again. The crucial fixture will come in session 15 when Inter entertain Upton Park, a win would appear essential for Lawton if he is to finally add the Moore title to his vast collection. The bottom 3 are beginning to look doomed although FFH Allstars gave themselves a shot in the arm with a late win over derby rivals Pcats Avengers. Steinbeck coolly slotted home a penalty after Taggly had handled inexplicably in the box, to give Hudson's men an outside chance of survival. Coatbrig Celts battled to a hard earned point at home to PSV Tinsley, a decent result in normal circumstances but not at this stage of the season when 3 points are a must to get out of trouble. Piedro de Oro cannot relax just yet after being held at home by bottom dogs Nagasaki Ninjas, although they did pick up a welcome point at Watchmen, to remain 6 points clear of the bottom three.

### **MARRAKESH IMplode**

Paul Sutton has had ample reason to celebrate lately with his beloved Luton Town finally making it to the Premier League. And so it was a clearly inebriated Sutton who turned up for duty with second placed Marrakesh this week for their fixture with struggling bottom side Lugg Vale. Sutton's team talk consisted of "These are shite lads, fill yer boots" before stumbling off to the directors box, where he was seen swigging champagne direct from the bottle before falling asleep. When woken up after 90 minutes, he enquired how many his side had won by. Unfortunately for him, an early Stockholm goal had given Lugg Vale a highly unexpected 1-0 win, dealing a huge blow to their promotion hopes. Next up 3 days later was a visit from league leaders Global Titans. A sheepish and unkempt Sutton was sat in the dug out for this one, hiding behind dark sunglasses, trying to ignore the insults from his own fans (and

Seamus, who was also strangely in attendance). Marrakesh put in a much better display in this match but were undone by the extreme creativity of Ashcroft's Titans. All their possession counted for very little as the Titans stole a 2-1 smash and grab victory, as Titans themselves made up for their own shock 2-0 defeat at Cliffvale Utd a few days earlier. All this meant we now have new leaders in Stark Reality. They had two very winnable games in FC United and Orlando Bhoys and made no mistake, collecting six points without conceding a goal. Hard to see the wily old campaigner Thompson not steering the Reality ship to promotion from here. Legia Lerner have also found their way into the top 3 at this crucial stage of the season, despite only drawing at Antrim FC. Miller went for the win with an attacking line up but Antrim are a tricky side to break down and held out for a 1-1 draw relatively comfortably. Don't rule out Gamla Stan for promotion either. They edged past The Polishers by a single goal, a good win despite The Polishers lowly position in the

table, Lawton's men are very much in a false position and should still escape relegation if that is the plan. Gamla may yet be distracted by their league cup exploits but it has the potential to be quite a season for the irascible Jens Jensen as they chase success on two fronts.

## A CLASS APART

Atletico Kazian have been a class apart in this division all season and now stand on the brink of promotion with 4 sessions to spare. Newark Legends and Broadstairs Utd both fought valiantly against the inevitable onslaught of Kazian but neither could hold out and it is now a matter of when, not if, promotion is confirmed. So, who will be joining them in division 2 next season? Well it looks like Lisbon Stags will be there, though they made hard work of their games this week. It took until 81 minutes before the Stags made the breakthrough against Broadstairs Utd, their strong midfield finally overcoming the Broadstairs resistance. Lisbon followed that up with a trip to bottom side Sweettooth but Butler's rather negative SW-3-4-2 formation with zonal marking meant that chances were at a premium and they were comfortably held to a disappointing 0-0 draw, which was enough to move Hudson's boys off the bottom. The third promotion spot is still very much up for grabs, with that position currently occupied by randy Rob Lewis's Dynamo Lambeth. A poor 0-0 draw at home to Avanta Hope was made better with a thumping 3-1 win at poor old Swinton Marine, to keep their noses ahead of Freedom City, Newark Legends and Broadstairs Utd, all of whom will still harbour genuine hopes of going up. Down at the bottom, Western Heroes move into the wooden spoon position after a dispiriting 1-0 loss to previous bottom dwellers Sweettooth. In fact it is not impossible that Fingers could end the season with the bottom 2 clubs, if Swinton Marine also continue their current downward trajectory. What an achievement that would be!

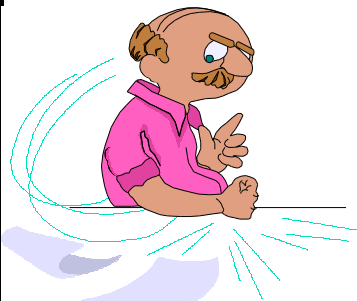

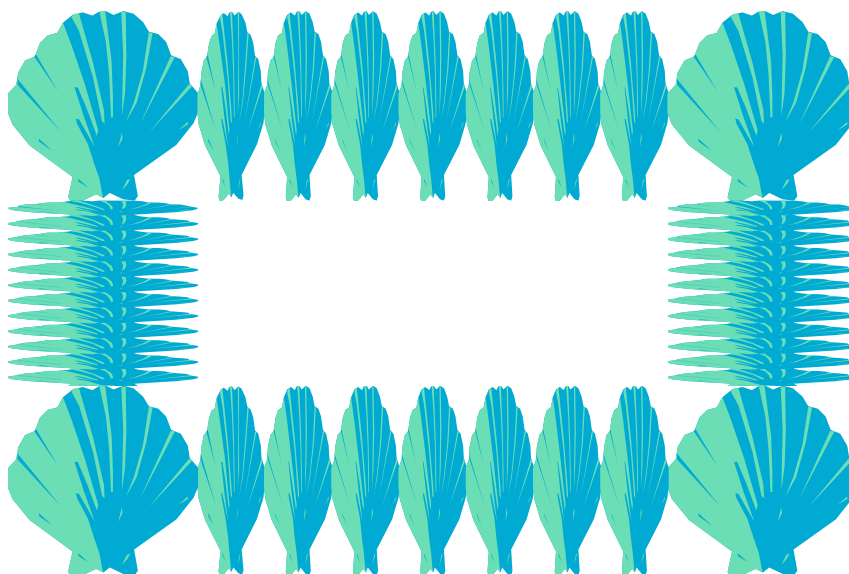

# CONTRACTS UPDATE

---

We have listened to the moaners who in contract negotiations have lost very good players cos they cannot get them to agree to a new contract. Galling to see their prized possession in the expired section of the autumn. Ok you will no doubt get some recompense for him, but the reserve bid is always painfully low and you never never know who might snaffle his arse with a cheeky bid do you.

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **Df/A X 2 / UT/WG/FWS x1.5** / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

***We suggest that you always add 1K to your bids***

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third of his basic wage
