ONCE AGAIN, IT'S ALL ABOUT THE HAM AT THE TOP OF THE TABLE

Being a derby game, the first half was a tactical affair with both sides looking for space to have a shot, but it wasn't until almost the hour mark for the

score was kept below double figures. Marrakesh started the day in 3rd place and they had a home game against Coatbrig Celts side that have seen better days, but have some excellent players in their team. Mr Sutton certainly knows how to build creative sides and he has his fair share of them under his stewardship here but despite this, they were finding it hard to find any space for their forwards. When the inevitable goal came, it was from the most unlikely source with Assassin sliding a delightful pass behind the Celts defence for Ayatollah to stride onto before sliding the ball under the despairing reach of the oncoming keeper, giving Marrakesh a 1-0 victory, moving them up to 2nd in the table. 9th placed FFH Allstars faced 7th placed Legia Lermmer in an early season derby game, and the Allstars took the lead with the first attack of the game, with the ball being crossed for Riis to head them into the lead with barely a minute on the clock and if that wasn't bad enough, Gruson got dismissed for Legia after kicking the goalscorer. Judging by the results in the league this week, it looks as if all positions in this division could well be up for grabs with nothing appearing to be a certainty.

Coming into this week, Broadstairs Utd were top of the table, the only team to pick up a full 9 points out of their first 3 games and all that without conceding a goal. This week they faced a trip to Bedfordshire to play 9th placed Avanta Hope, a team that are hard to score against, but equally find it hard to score goals themselves. With both sides fielding big midfielders, it was all about who could create chances out of nothing and it was the home team that took advantage of a slip-up in the Broadstairs defence, allowing Hamilton to clip the ball over the United keeper to put the home side ahead, and once they had that lead, they swapped to a defensive stance and were able to comfortably contain Broadstairs so they could run out 1-0 victors.

Second placed Dynamo Lambeth also had an away game to play against Orlando Bhoys, and with both teams being power heavy as well as lining up with identical formations, it was no surprise to anyone present that both teams cancelled one another out as both sides were unable to create any shots on target, leaving the game to finish 0-0. Western Heroes did come into the week in 3rd place and had an away game against bottom of the table Blackadder FC to contend with, and with the home side playing a sweeper to contend with the Heroes creative forward line, they were able to contain anything their opponents threw at them and once Sofia put the home side ahead in the 31st minute, Blackadder adopted a 'what we have, we hold' mentality to their lead and not allowing the Heroes

any chance to get back into the game. In 4th place were, surprisingly, a rebuilding Swinton Marine side that were trying to get some quality back into their side, and with a visit to Sweettooth, they thought it was as a chance as any to pick up some points but fielding 2 youngsters in his matchday side, he was effectively ceding to his opponents and Sweettooth took full advantage of this although it took them until the start of the second half to take the lead with Sherbert heading home from a corner and he repeated the feat 8 minutes later. Despite having some creative players, the Heroes were unable to create anything to worry their opponents, with the game ending in a 2-0 victory to Sweettooth FC. 5th placed Walsall Heath had to travel to play FC United, and despite an over enthusiastic effort from Walsall, United were able to keep them at arm's length while at the same time, running into the brick wall that was Walsall's keeper/sweeper combo, adding to their marking of the United forwards, which produced mixed results. Fans had to wait until the 73rd minute before they could celebrate as Boerrr crossed the ball to the edge of the area for Brent to crash in a perfectly hit volley into the bottom corner to give FC United a hard fought 1-0 win. Final game in the division saw 10th placed Lugg Vale FC host 6th placed Newark Legends and in a game that Newark dominated possession, they weren't able to break down the Lugg Vale back line leaving the game to finish 0-0.

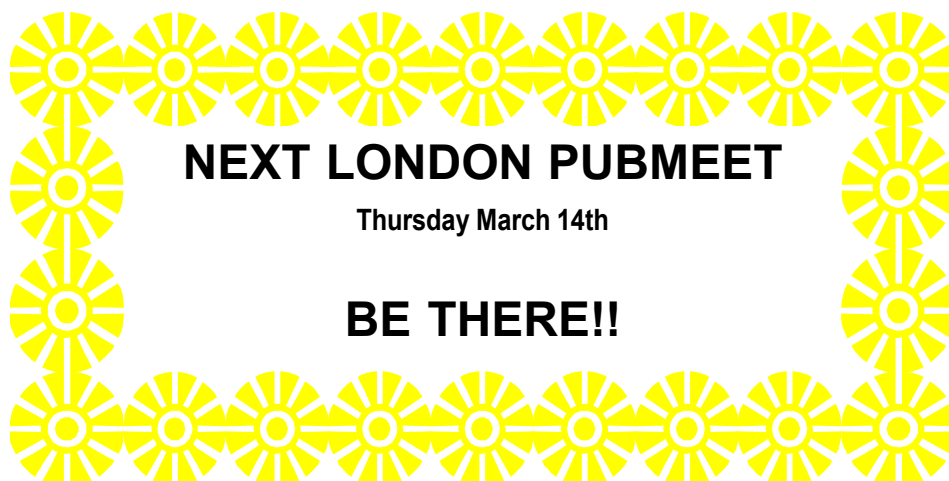

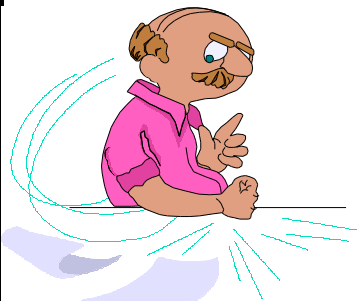

So from now onwards if you use last season's numbers then you will be found out AND if guilty the result of the game will either be reversed or decided against you.

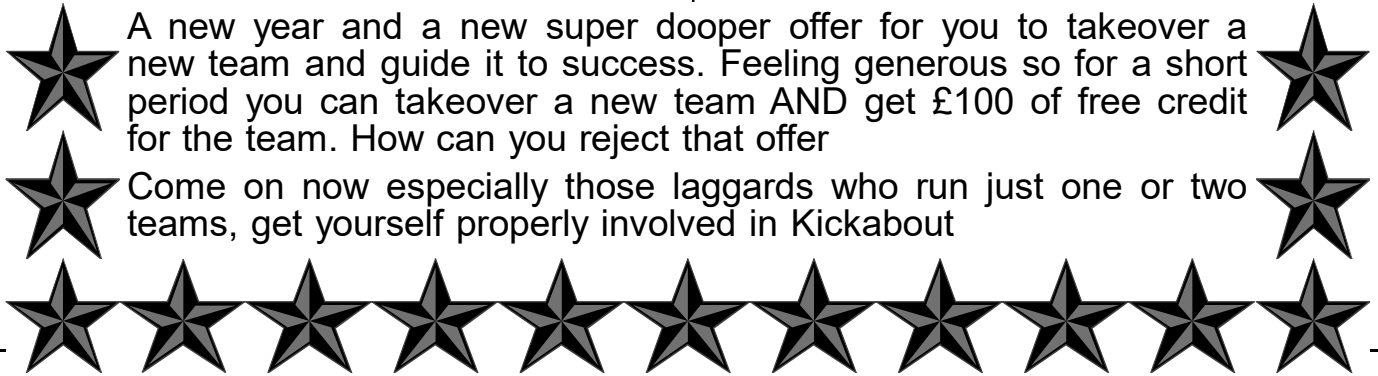

CONTRACTS UPDATE

We have listened to the moaners who in contract negotiations have lost very good players cos they cannot get them to agree to a new contract. Galling to see their prized possession in the expired section of the autumn. Ok you will no doubt get some recompense for him, but the reserve bid is always painfully low and you never never know who might snaffle his arse with a cheeky bid do you.

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **Df/A X 2 / UT/WG/FWS x1.5** / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

We suggest that you always add 1K to your bids

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third of his basic wage
