

RAPIDE IMPROVEMENT

The big story in Division One is the improvement being shown by **Rapide Rapace** as Dag has managed, it appears, to assure safety in the top flight for another season. The fans will be hoping for a better season next time out though, so still plenty to do. However, two wins from two this week goes a long way to showing some of the work that is being done, along with an exciting transfer deal as well. In their first game, Rapide were up against struggling **Owlerton FC**, one place below them at the start of the day, but level on points. However, Rapide were always on top in this one, from the moment the first whistle blew until the end. Owlerton had packed the defence in the hope of keeping Rapide out, tacklers and blockers the order of the day, and this worked until the second half. Just ten minutes into the second half, though, tricky winger MUHREN found himself free in the box, and fired home from close range. Rapide had all the chances, though PEDRO CAPTANEZ thought he had snatched a draw for the visitors late on, only to see his snap shot cleared off the line by HIRO, with MONTRWAUX beaten. However, Rapide Rapace took the spoils, and continue to climb the table.

In their second game, Rapide Rapace faced a much sterner test, going away to derby rivals **Bolton Wands**. Bolton have not quite been firing on all cylinders this season, and while the crowd of over 71,000 were baying for a home victory, Dag had other ideas. Bolton had been held to a goalless home draw by **Hannover96** in their first game of the week, and things went from bad to worse as early as the 21st minute when FARMER headed home MUHREN's wicked cross. The two teams, in similar formations with packed midfields, cancelled each other out, and MONTRWAUX was up to anything that Bolton could throw at him, which to be fair, was not much. Rapide held on for a famous win, climbing to 7th place in the table in the process. Meanwhile, **St Peters** and **Croydon Flyers** both had wins in the first round of matches, then cancelled each other out in a goalless draw in the second, to push Bolton down into third place, now five points behind St Peters at the top of the table.

DOWN TO THE WIRE

The promotion race in the Second Division looks like it will be going right down to the wire. There are currently five teams involved, looking for the three promotion places up into the bright lights of the First Division. Leading the way, still, are **Wycombe Town**, picking up another six points in their march to the title. Their first opponents, **Fulham Lumens**, are right down near the foot of the table, so manager Read will have had no worries about this one. True to form, young midfielder WELSBY fired home, his first goal of the season, just before the half-hour, and then scored his second, a crashing volley, in the second half to secure the points. Wycombe didn't have this one all their own way, and Fulham could take heart from the chances they created against their much vaunted opponents. Wycombe won't worry, they got the points and marched on to meet their next opponents, **The Family Cat**, in second place and smarting from being held to a goalless draw by strugglers **Istel Palace**. Wycombe manager Read had done his homework, and marked The Family Cat's two best midfielders out of the game. That done, it was down to who could find the net, and the prize went to PALPATIN (of course!) nodding in his 15th goal of the

season, to set down a real marker for the rest of the division. To make matters worse for the visitors, forward RODRIGO picked up two late yellow cards, and now faces some time on the sidelines as a result.

Purple Hearts climb into second place as a result of The Cat's struggles, picking up two wins themselves. Their first game was a 2-1 win over **FC West Trip**, and their second a 3-2 victory over **Crusaders FC**. The outlook of manager Barrett is just to ensure his team score more than the opponents. They will always leak goals, but they are so dangerous going forward! A similar outlook is that held by manager Stevens at **Chiaroscuro** who are in fourth and trying to keep up with the top three. They are only three points off the promotion places after a glorious session, 5-0 away against **Elegant Chaos** followed up by a 4-0 win at home against **Cryogenix**. Two games without conceding is a rarity for The Dons, but they were playing two of the bottom teams in the division. The promotion hunt is still on. Same to for **Viking Raiders**, another three points further back, but with a game in hand. They picked up four points from their double-header with **Typhoon Loftus**, surprisingly being held on home turf, unable to find a way through to goal.

That is their big weakness, and what might ultimately cost them promotion, as they have the best defence in the division by some margin. They did make some amends, winning 1-0 away from home in the return, NKANTE grabbing the only goal of a game that saw both sides lose players to injuries.

Down at the bottom, **Fulham Lumens** gave themselves some breathing space, winning 2-0 away from home against relegation rivals **Istel Palace** - a real six pointer if ever there was one. That win, along with **Istel Palace's** aforementioned draw, drags **Cryogenix** right down into the mire. Can **Sutton** pull off some sort of miracle between now and the end of the season to keep them up?

BECOMING CLEARER

This is the case in the Third Division, as the situation seems to be becoming slightly clearer at both ends of the table, with **Red Star Cevile** losing ground at the top, and **Wolfpack FC** putting some daylight between themselves and the relegation zone at the bottom. At the top, then, leaders **Paris Angels** continued their fine form, sneaking a narrow 2-1 derby win against **Anfield Stars** in the first match, then demolishing them 6-0 at home in the return match just a few days later. Bragging rights well and truly achieved, eight different players scoring the eight goals across the two matches. **Blackburn Rvrs** matched them with two wins from two, to move up into third spot. First off was a 2-0 away win over **Holland Pk West**, just about putting to bed any thoughts they had about promotion. **ZAKOPANE** was the hero for the Rovers, scoring a brace in a five minute period midway through the second half. **Blackburn's** second match was at home against **United OB**, which ended up a routine 3-0, total domination throughout the match, with goals from **QUARESMA** and **King** giving them the win.

The reason **Red Star Cevile** have lost ground is because **Twin Peaks FC** beat them 2-0 on their own ground in the first round of matches. **Red Star's** negative approach to the match costing them dear as **BOB** and **EARLE** scored, one in each half to take the win for the visitors. **Twin Peaks** could not take further advantage, slipping to third place in the process, as they were held goalless by local rivals **Jovian Giants** in their second match, while **Red Star** took a win over **Wolfpack FC**, **CRAIGH's** first half goal the difference. However, the difference from third place to **Red Star** is now four points. Can they claw it back?

Down at the bottom, **Wolfpack FC** defeated **Nottingham FC** by 1-0. **Nottingham** were tipped by some pundits, not too long ago, as potential promotion candidates, but have gone into freefall since then, taking just one point from the last three matches. **Wolfpack**, on the other hand, tipped as relegation favourites, have picked up two wins in three matches, to emerge from the relegation zone.

THREE FROM FOUR

Who is going to miss out on the promotion party in Division Four? At the moment, just three points covers the top four teams after the two latest rounds of matches. **AFC Corella** continue to lead the way, beating **Travellers FC** comfortably in their second game, having been held goalless by **Old Josephians** in their first game. After that goalless draw, **Old Josephians** narrowly defeated **Dark City** 2-1 in their second match, **BERGKAMP** with a brace either side of **BERT-GERK** scoring his second goal in two games for two games for the visitors, to show just how far they have come this season.

Uptown Funk are the form team of the four at the moment, picking up a maximum six points this week. Their first match was an easy 2-0 win over a poor **Walsall Heath**, second half goals from **VON BLUCHER** and **VELAZQUEZ** giving them the points. Their second win was a more impressive 3-0 over **Tiverton Tigers**, who themselves had racked up a 3-0 win over **Trachloe Villa** in the first round of matches. Both teams were oozing confidence coming into this one, but in the end it was the home side who had all the chances. Again, it took until the second half before they managed to score, but manager **Symonds** team-talk obviously did the business, as within three minutes of the re-start, they were 2-0 up, **VERBOTEN** and **PINATUBO** with the goals. **MURFREESBORO** made it 3-0 just after the hour mark, flicking home **DEBUSSY's** swinging cross to seal the win. **Uptown Funk** are flying! On the other hand, **Bluesville FC**, while still in second place, look like the team who might just miss out. AUCTION HIGHLIGHTS

Big spenders in the auction this week are **Hannover96**, splashing out 4.5 million on the young injured starlet NATCHO, big things expected of him over the next couple of seasons. 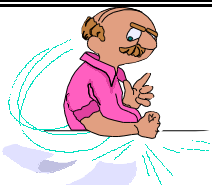

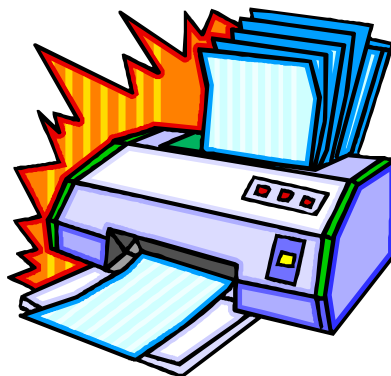

CONTRACTS UPDATE

We have listened to the moaners who in contract negotiations have lost very good players cos they cannot get them to agree to a new contract. Galling to see their prized possession in the expired section of the autumn. Ok you will no doubt get some recompense for him, but the reserve bid is always painfully low and you never never know who might snaffle his arse with a cheeky bid do you.

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **DF/A X 2** /

UT/WG/FWS x1.5 / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

We suggest that you always add 1K to your bids

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K per week

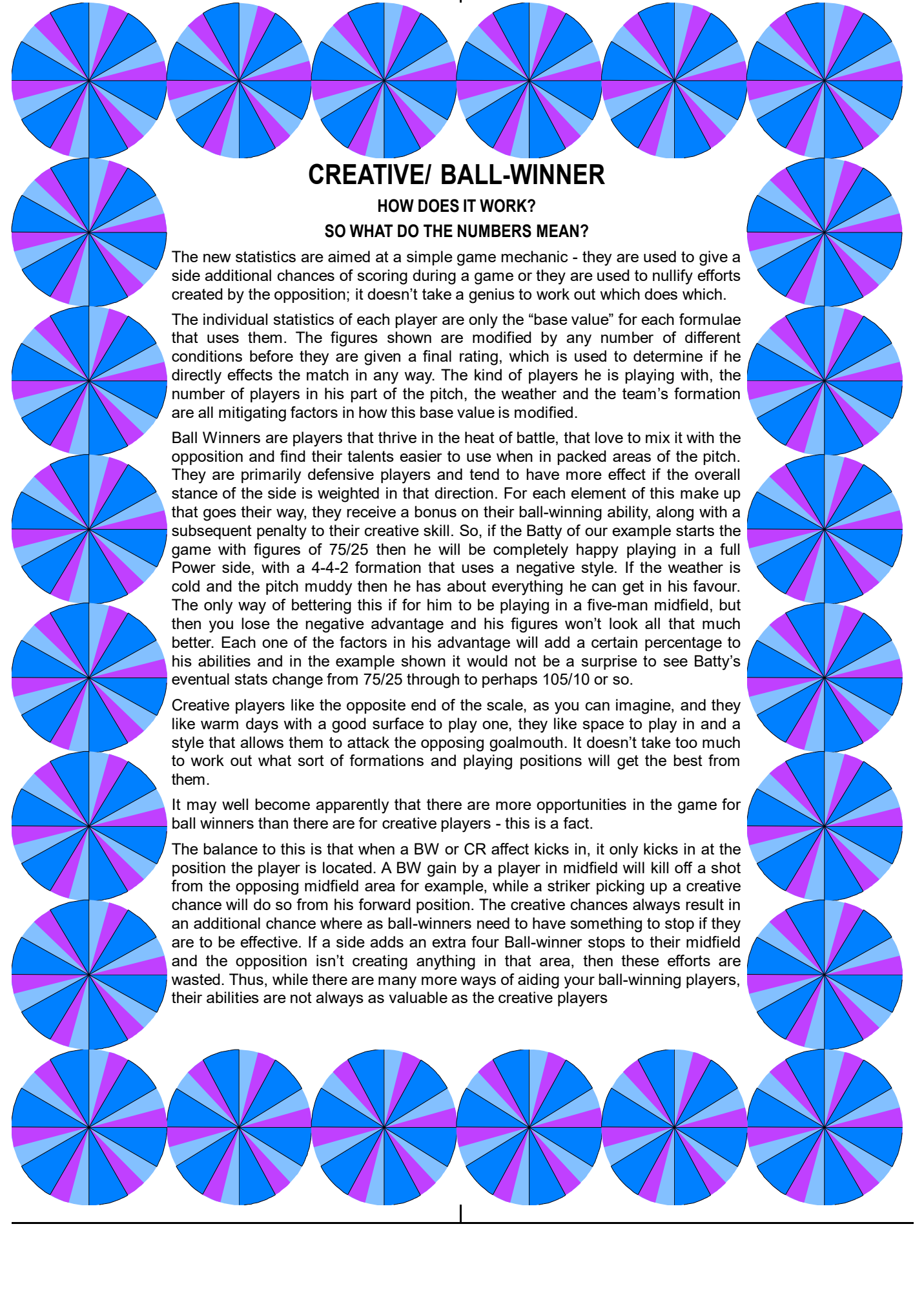
or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third of his basic wage

· so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K



CREATIVE/ BALL-WINNER

HOW DOES IT WORK?

SO WHAT DO THE NUMBERS MEAN?

The new statistics are aimed at a simple game mechanic - they are used to give a side additional chances of scoring during a game or they are used to nullify efforts created by the opposition; it doesn't take a genius to work out which does which.

The individual statistics of each player are only the "base value" for each formulae that uses them. The figures shown are modified by any number of different conditions before they are given a final rating, which is used to determine if he directly effects the match in any way. The kind of players he is playing with, the number of players in his part of the pitch, the weather and the team's formation are all mitigating factors in how this base value is modified.

Ball Winners are players that thrive in the heat of battle, that love to mix it with the opposition and find their talents easier to use when in packed areas of the pitch. They are primarily defensive players and tend to have more effect if the overall stance of the side is weighted in that direction. For each element of this make up that goes their way, they receive a bonus on their ball-winning ability, along with a subsequent penalty to their creative skill. So, if the Batty of our example starts the game with figures of 75/25 then he will be completely happy playing in a full Power side, with a 4-4-2 formation that uses a negative style. If the weather is cold and the pitch muddy then he has about everything he can get in his favour. The only way of bettering this if for him to be playing in a five-man midfield, but then you lose the negative advantage and his figures won't look all that much better. Each one of the factors in his advantage will add a certain percentage to his abilities and in the example shown it would not be a surprise to see Batty's eventual stats change from 75/25 through to perhaps 105/10 or so.

Creative players like the opposite end of the scale, as you can imagine, and they like warm days with a good surface to play one, they like space to play in and a style that allows them to attack the opposing goalmouth. It doesn't take too much to work out what sort of formations and playing positions will get the best from them.

It may well become apparently that there are more opportunities in the game for ball winners than there are for creative players - this is a fact.

The balance to this is that when a BW or CR affect kicks in, it only kicks in at the position the player is located. A BW gain by a player in midfield will kill off a shot from the opposing midfield area for example, while a striker picking up a creative chance will do so from his forward position. The creative chances always result in an additional chance where as ball-winners need to have something to stop if they are to be effective. If a side adds an extra four Ball-winner stops to their midfield and the opposition isn't creating anything in that area, then these efforts are wasted. Thus, while there are many more ways of aiding your ball-winning players, their abilities are not always as valuable as the creative players
