



CATTON STILL IN CONTROL

There is quite a battle developing once again at the top of division one with Catton still in prime position after an easy 3-0 win at poor old Romsey Rovers. Jack Smith has got no chance with this Romsey squad currently as they are ridden with injuries and suspensions, with SIX first teamers missing this week. Not sure they would have made too much difference against Catton but it certainly doesn't help! Steelcity Hawks kept pace with the leaders after an impressive 3-0 win away at The Mashers, never an easy place to go. Craig's boys are motoring now and all eyes will be on session 15 when the top 2 clash in a possible title decider. Don't completely rule out Bristol Rovers either, they are clinging on gamely after grinding past FC Trentside 1-0, could Ian Read pull off a major surprise by sneaking ahead of the big two? Probably not but you never know! Bilbao Rocks will be kicking themselves after losing 1-0 to a Brutal Maniacs side missing injured goalie Remi and their best defender Trimble. Bilbao were also missing their best player Gerhard but really should have tested out rookie apprentice keeper Shilton more often than they did. Looks like 4th is where they will finish now. Sprowston Youth managed to scrape a 1-1 draw with Westminster Utd, despite playing quite a few of the youth team. Alkesh Patel appears to be wisely looking ahead to next season now as they are going to get relegated for sure. Two points dropped for Gareth's boys here though. Finally, MM Marauders keep their very faint hopes of survival alive after beating nearest rivals Newark Harriers by a single goal. Heigham Town, a result no one would have seen coming, least of all Bard Moller. Heigham keeper Melmoth played out of his skin and Moore's boys have renewed hope in their battle to avoid the drop. Greymouth Town took advantage of the struggles of those above them to record an easy 2-0 win over a fading Perfect FC. McCauley might just be timing his run to perfection? Don't write off Rio either. They may have struggled to see off Villa Rangers 1-0 but they are only 3 points off 3rd spot and are nobodies pushovers. Quite a battle brewing up to be honest. Finally, bottom side Kickabouts miss the chance to record a rare win over struggling Reale Hastings. Both teams were missing important players but Hastings, now under the stewardship of John Canvin, might look back at this game with regret if they end up slipping through the trap door, given the results of the teams around them this session.

A QUIET WEEK

Nothing much to report in division 3 this week as virtually everything went to form. Estarcion FC stay clear at the top, easily seeing off rebuilding Van Boro 3-0. Glencairn are in the final promotion spot but they had to work hard to get past a stubborn Hawk Fields outfit. It always

felt like one of those games where the first goal would win it and so it proved when La Droit put Glencairn ahead late in the first half. No moans from Mansell about goalkeepers today! The Wee Rovers put out a 5 man attack against Gutter Press, showing Rob Lewis has learned absolutely nothing from his idol Roy Hodgson. Or maybe he has, as they ended up drawing 0-0 anyway! Gutter Press drop to 4th and out of the promotion spots. The Levellers and Everton Classics played out a bad tempered mid table derby which also ended goalless. 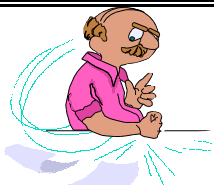

CONTRACTS UPDATE

We have listened to the moaners who in contract negotiations have lost very good players cos they cannot get them to agree to a new contract. Galling to see their prized possession in the expired section of the autumn. Ok you will no doubt get some recompense for him, but the reserve bid is always painfully low and you never never know who might snaffle his arse with a cheeky bid do you.

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **DF/A X 2** / **UT/WG/FWS x1.5** / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

We suggest that you always add 1K to your bids

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third of his basic wage

· so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K

one unqual sbby of 6.5 qual (random outfield)

one 18-2 FUT (manager chooses position)

No promotion or relegation at end of first season

Certain parts of each auction would be just for div 4 managers

First season free, second season £20
