



CROYDON FLYING

Well, with only four games left of this season, the first division title could still be going to any one of four different teams. This week, it was **Croydon Flyers'** turn to hit the top of the table, as manager Ashcroft seeks the glory of the title. The manager was a bit pensive at the beginning of this one, as they lined up against former champs **Martino FC**, Ashcroft was missing a couple of key players, and he was hoping that their replacements were going to be up to it. In the end, they were, as he got his marking tactics spot on, and DEMBA and JEORGIE BAST were tracked all over the pitch. THE CAT GOT THE CREAM

Big games in the second division as the top four all played off against each other this week, and the promotion race maybe became slightly clearer. The big winners of the four were **The Family Cat**, who were playing against **Purple Hearts**, who started the day 1 place and four points above them. However, by the end of the day, the gap had come down to just 1 point as the Family Cat took all three points. Manager Barrett and sent his Purple Hearts side out to zonally mark the home side, while Abrahams told his team to just go out and play their own game. This seemed to be the better approach for them, as they forged into a 2-0 lead in the first half, SCHENK and POLASKI finding space and firing home 5 minutes apart. One less happy manager today is Humphries of **Paris Angels**, who were held to a goalless draw by **Jovian Giants**. Paris were on top throughout, but just could not find a way past BROUGHTON and GORBAN at the back for the Giants. Goalless it ended, and so the gap at the top is down to two points. Can Blackburn still sneak it?

Down at the bottom, there was a vital win for **Wolfpack FC** to drag them out of the relegation spaces. If **Redden Court** had a manager, they would be fuming after this one, with Seamus sending his Wolf Pack out to kick anything that moved in this tough derby encounter. Four yellow cards they picked up, while inflicting three injuries on their opponents. When asked about this afterwards, Seamus simply shrugged and held up three fingers. "Three goals, three points, so what?" he said, before walking off to celebrate with his players.

STILL TIGHT

The title charge in the fourth division is still so tight! Actually, every division in this league is looking tight going into the last few weeks of the season. **AFC Corella** remain top, still unbeaten, still hardly conceding any goals, but unable to beat **Tiverton Tigers** this week. Corella were missing a couple of key players for this match, and the Tigers almost took advantage of that. They managed to do something that hardly anyone else has done, as they scored in the first half, just the third goal this Corella defence has conceded all season. It looked as though O'SHAY had done enough, but then defender AJER headed home late on to tie the scores at 1-1, and that was how it finished. **Old Josephians**, who started the day in second, were also held to a draw, maybe surprisingly, by the wily old fox manager Mansell and his **Trachloe Villa** side, who are starting to understand what their manager wants from them.

Making the most of that stutter are **Uptown Funk**, who burst into second place, beating **Travellers FC** by a single goal to nil. It should have been a lot more, but keeper CASTILLAS had a superb game for the home side, blocking, stopping, saving and shouting all afternoon. It was just the one goal, the twenty yard volley from MEGALLAN that beat him, and that beat Travellers. Symonds will have wanted more, but it was still three points. Also taking three points, and so keeping right in touch with the fight at the top are **Bluesville FC**, who had dropped slightly off the pace over recent weeks, but are now still right back in with a shout again. Very tough to beat, goals from PUFFO PUSKAS and DRIPUNKT PADICH gave them a solid 2-0 win over **Walsall Heath**, and puts them back level on points with Old Josephians. Still some very important games to come before the end of the season, as some of these four still have to play each other again.

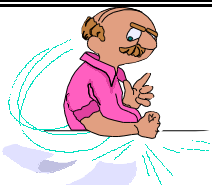

CONTRACTS UPDATE

We have listened to the moaners who in contract negotiations have lost very good players cos they cannot get them to agree to a new contract. Galling to see their prized possession in the expired section of the autumn. Ok you will no doubt get some recompense for him, but the reserve bid is always painfully low and you never never know who might snaffle his arse with a cheeky bid do you.

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **DF/A X 2** / **UT/WG/FWS x1.5** / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

We suggest that you always add 1K to your bids

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third of his basic wage

· so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K

The Shakespeare League

The Shokie is nice league which hasn't really got a super team, so competitive indeed. However, for some reason it has been leaking players and now is in the position that it needs a fresh infusion of new blood. I have a fix for this and that is to inject some 36-1 clubs into division four.

Suggestion is the normal set up in terms of ground/ sps etc

But starting cash would be 1000K

ten random 36-1 players

one 19-12 outfield player (not gk or sw) (managers choice)

one unequal sbv of 6.5 qual (random outfield)

one 18-2 FUT (manager chooses position)

No promotion or relegation at end of first season

Certain parts of each auction would be just for div 4 managers

First season free, second season £20
