NETHERTON AT THE DOUBLE

NETHERTON FC 1 : 0 BUGMAN RANGERS

As the season headed to a close, a crowd of nearly 70,000 headed to Wembley on a sunny afternoon for the showcase Cup Final, champions **Netherton FC** up against near challengers **Bugman Rangers**. The match had been sold out for weeks, with the crowds from both teams competing with the neutrals for the coveted tickets. Netherton came into the match on a high, having already secured the league title, while Bugman also had fresh memories of triumph, just a few weeks ago holding aloft the League Cup at this same ground. Both teams were lined up in identical SW-2-5-2 formations, that extra line of defence designed as well to give the midfielders the space to do the tracking back they are all called on to do. After a slightly tense and cagey start, it became clear to all that Bugman were more inclined to sit back and defend, hoping to catch their opponents on the break. SANTOS DOWNED

At the top, **Netherton** did what they needed to do, holding **Dore Utd** comfortably at arms length to finish the season unbeaten, with the best defensive record and top scorer to boot. They are going to be a hard act to beat again next season, but that does all depend on what happens over the close season. On the day, it was a game that could have gone either way, but both keepers were up to the task, and it all ended goalless, with Netherton awarded the league trophy at the end of the match. Their fans stayed on long after the final whistle, while the fans from Dore Utd left quickly, hoping that manager Lawton has a plan of attack next season.

Thomoslavia sneaked up into third place, taking advantage of **Danetown** and **Bugman** only being able to pick up draws, by smashing seven past poor unloved, unmanaged **Aliens Utd**, who crash out of the division. PADDY O'RILEY and LEEK grabbed a couple of goals each, leaving Tommo with a great big smile on his face, and no doubt European football, next season.

At the bottom, **Nacional** secured their top flight status, as **CFC Santos** had obviously decided to accept their fate, and begin planning for life in division two. In the eagerly awaited match between the two sides, n

actually it wasn't a match, it was a display, as Nacional scored 10 (yes TEN!) without reply. CFC Santos took the opportunity to blood some youngsters, and the score really could have been double what it was. It was a similar story in the rearranged game, as Santos did a similar thing against Aliens Utd and went down by 7-0. Nacional then it is who stay up, while Santos join **Ackworth** and Aliens in division 2 next season.

CHAMPIONS, BUT ONLY JUST

Dumnonia City have wobbled over recent weeks, having looked halfway through the season as though they were going to run away with the division two title. Going into the last round of matches they were just one point ahead of **Yorkshire Rams**, who were closing on them like an express train. It had looked as though they might lose their grip on the top spot, but it wasn't to be. Fortunately for them, their opponents today, **Grafar Mill FC**, got this one all wrong, charging a four man forward line into the Dumnonia offside trap, while also have confusing instructions to get behind the ball whenever possible. Dumnonia, despite missing two of their best players through injury, ruled the midfield, and took control. The first goal came on 23 minutes, ROMA lobbing the keeper from a full thirty yards. In the end, even though the fans had their ears glued to their radios for news of rivals, **Yorkshire Rams**, it didn't matter what the Rams did, as Dumnonia did enough on their own to take the title. Which was just as well, because Yorkshire were putting in a scintillating performance, demolishing **Bedford House** 8-0. Determined to end the season on a high, they took full advantage of the fact that Bedford were forced into playing young TOLOMEO in goal, and tested him at every opportunity, giving the poor lad no chance whatsoever.

FC United Boys take the third promotion place, edging past doomed **AFC Broadway** 1-0 thanks to FAARAGE's late goal, while **Glasgow Celtic** went down 3-1 to **Temple City** and drop to fourth place, to contest another season in division two. **Kirkdeen Utd** almost did enough to catch Grafar and Bedford House, but not quite, and despite beating **Anfield Rovers** 4-0 on their own ground, they still drop down into the third. However, if they can recapture some of their recent form next season, they will have a stunning season next time out.

ALL SETTLED

Much more straight forward in the third division, with the top two each racking up 3-0 wins to maintain those positions. **AFC Lowfields** will be cursing the fixture draw, as they ended up playing champions **Margate Beach** twice in the last two sessions of the season, and miss out on promotion. Margate came through comfortably to take the title in the end, with that 3-0 derby win over Lowfields making it certain. The tone was set early on, when RAMOS for the visitors aimed a kick at NORINT in the first minute, which saw him get a yellow card. However, Margate were not put off their stride, with NELSON putting them ahead on 12 minutes, with top scorer LEFUOL adding two more, on in each half. Lowfields tried to assert themselves, but just ended up down to ten men, ANDRASSY sent off for strong-arming LEFUOL one too many times! **Crimson Kings** held on to second place, comfortably easing past **Jackdaws Castle** by 3-0, BAROTELLI setting them on their way after just two minutes, and **Marx Men** cemented third place by beating **Colour Athletic** 4-2. They really have had a fine second half of the season, and manager Mansell will be hoping he can keep the same form going.

At the bottom, **Denmra Arsenal** picked up another three points to confirm their status in the division, putting a helpless **Golf City** to the sword and scoring 4 without reply. **Crewe Alexandra** could do nothing about it, and join Golf City and Jackdaws Castle in relegation after falling 1-0 to **Norwood Eagles**.

CELTS ON THE UP

In the basement division, it was just the third promotion place that was up for grabs, as **Rotorua Mist FC** and **Samdoria** had already claimed first and second spots. All sorts of shenanigans have been going on, as the various managers jockey for position, mostly it seems, aiming for fourth and below, rather than third. However, with the dust now settled, it is **Connacht Celts** who will be going up with them, as their recent form took them up into third. In this final round of matches, they were away to **Inter-Orlando**, who were one of the few teams not in with a shout of going up. Connacht are a strong team now, and once DI MARIO had been sent off early on for the home side, there was only ever one winner. ROMELU put them ahead on 18 minutes, the big man first to WANG WUN IN's cross, and his header giving the keeper no chance. Captain O'DEARSON made it two, smashing a loose ball home, and then FAIRLEE made it three on the 80th minute, heading home from a corner, to take the Celts up.

Fujian Pirates almost did enough to unwillingly overtake them, defeating fellow promotion avoiders **Broughton Villa** by 3-2. Two as yet unqualified schoolboys, and no fewer than six other reserves on the pitch tells the story, but both managers have achieved their goal of remaining in the division for another season, in the hope of more time to build their squads. Broughton Villa actually took the lead against the run of play, MCSAMSON putting the ball into his own net with keeper FORMOSA badly out of position. The lead didn't last long though, with goals from RAGNAR, KAO SHUNG and CHEN putting the visitors ahead. IAN SMITH made it 3-2 late on, though Humphries looked like he knew it was already too late for them to get promotion. Will the plan have worked, or is this one huge backfire? I guess we will know more next season.

These are also the same levels which decide whether a player will go straight to N/L when out of contract rather than being put into the auction

AUCTION NOTES

From now onwards we would like you to always write, 'don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box EVEN IF HE IS A LEVEL TWELVE STAR, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM as during the transfers we have no way of knowing whether a player has become level twelve in THAT SESSION.!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item. However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

LSO, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems. Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!

NB In teampick trophy games come after League Cup it appears. Please realise that they don't. In the fullness of time the temapick maestro will change this

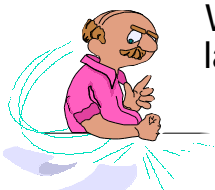

MARKING UPDATE

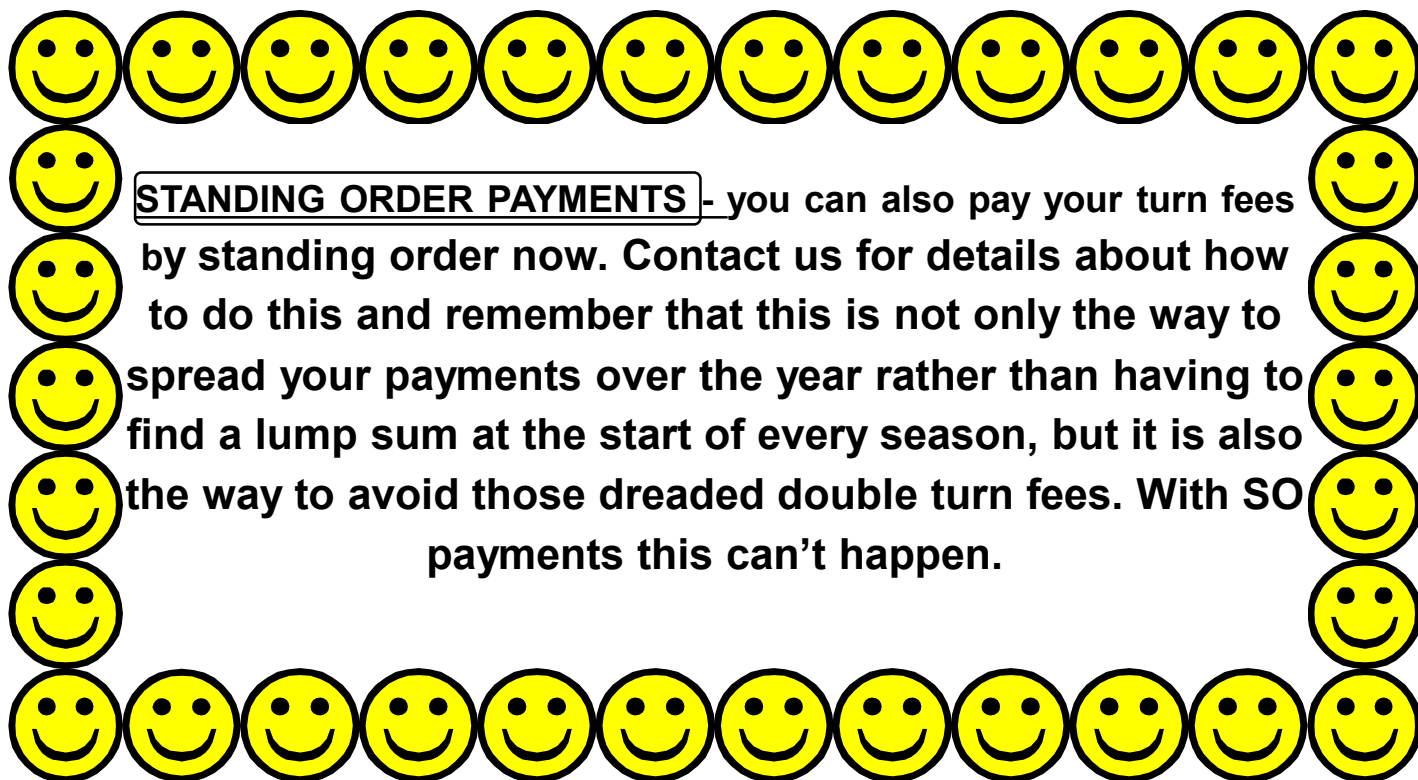

You will all notice a new stat on your turnsheets. In the space where BW/CR stats are listed there will be a X% number against all goalkeepers. This will rate your GK on his shot-saving ability and will be cumulative.

Two points to note. It does not include penalties and own goals, but does include friendlies. And before shouting that it is wrong, remember that all shots against you are tested against the sweeper for blocking them before the GK.

I have some ideas about how to use this stat in the future so watch this space

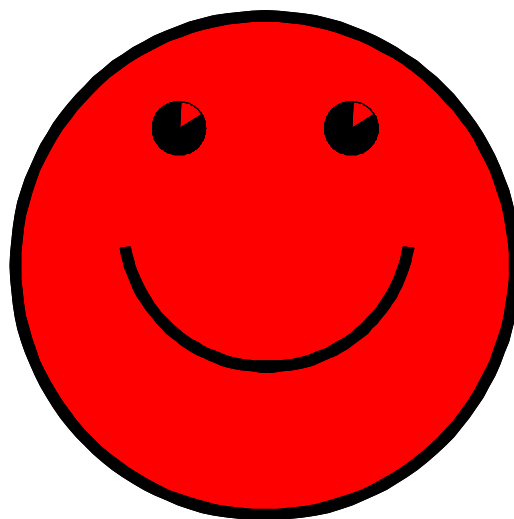

TEAMPICK

Teampick is a program available for all PC owners who have windows on their machine. It allows you to manipulate your team on screen to look at differing formations and conditions. This automatically works out the factors which will affect your team, helps prevent errors, and all sorts of things into the bargain. It also prints out your team sheet, and you can then get the program to format an Email team sheet for submitting instead of the normal order sheets, if you so choose. The program also has an on-line rulebook, i.e., you can dial up the relevant section of the rulebook at the click of the mouse and read that part of the rules while selecting your team. If you can't remember how the weather affects things, when your captain moves onto an extra level, or the formulas that govern transfer negotiations and marking, well just ask the computer! Subscribers also get a .kik file which upgrades your team details every session as well making it even easier for you. Even better news is that the program is FREE to all players who sign up for Shomatch.

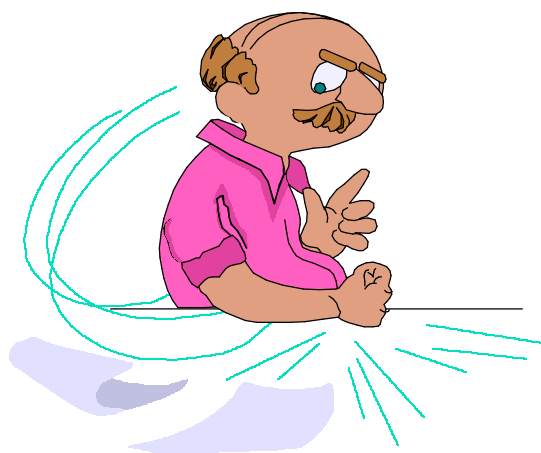

SHOMATCH

For those who don't already know Shomatch is our very own tele-printer in which you get the results, the newsletter and league tables on it, plus a minute by minute printout of the state of your game. Nail-biting to watch if you've got a particularly important game to play. Far better, and definitely more nerve-wracking than just tearing the newsletter open and seeing your fate decided in the flash of a micro-second. This is only available to those who have email players as everything is sent to you as an email which shomatch interprets and displays to you on your PC screen. But not only do you get the tele-printer printout and the league tables, but we send you a number of extra files which include the results, suspensions, Euro results, international results, rep results and the like. All of these can be displayed and watched as they tick through minute by minute as well. Thanks to the programming skills of Paul Sutton, shomatch now runs under windows, with pictures, sound effects and the like making it an even more gripping experience for the real masochists amongst you!!

If you are playing the game from abroad by Email, and who doesn't receive any hardcopy newsletters (mainly those who are playing from outside of continental Europe, MUST purchase shomatch as it is via this that we send your results, newsletters (in PDF format now), and the like. It's up to the rest of you whether you subscribe to this and get your results earlier than the hardcopy comes out. But for the overseas player it is a boon allowing them a little bit extra time to complete their orders - something that they were always moaning about in the past!

What is the cost then. Well you have to pay a single fee of £17.95 which covers a season of sign-ups for Shomatch. For this you get all the information above, and for this one fee you can request shomatch and related details for any league you want to. You aren't restricted to just the leagues you are playing in,. Euro contestants can watch their rivals and plan for when they meet them in this way. You'll see a box on your season start-up sheets which says sign me up for Shomatch. Tick this, enclose the cash and indicate which league you want to subscribe to and we'll do the rest. The team name should be the first thing on the start-up papers you send back to us (makes it much easier for filing at our end!). And on one sheet, please don't put extra blank lines in your start up (some people do!0

If you need to re-do a team for some reason then all you get is 100 levels + 100K, , please contact us before you re-do any team to talk about it.

Also, your subscription for Shomatch/Teampick will be taken from the first league that you receive a start-up for so please ensure you have enough to cover it

Remember you may only re-name your side if it is not a first division side and if you took them over during THIS season. Certain teams with a history who are now in the lower divisions cannot be re-named either.

Also, please DO NOT, say same as lasts season for nicknames (**Paul STEVENS** note), ground colours, put something in the box to save us from having to look up what your last decisions were. some of you might enjoy playing in asshole park, which is what we are likely to choose for you!! If you use the teampick start up sheet then you only have to do this once and never again

Finally, get your start up sheet back soonest with any payment, then we can get the new season going, it is a pain having to chase people for things.
