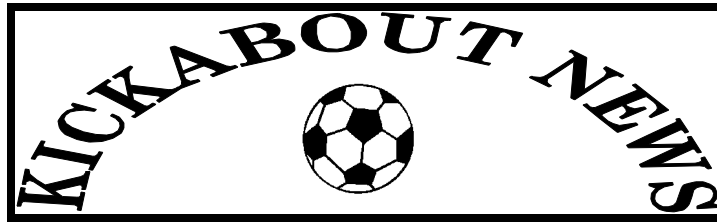

SESSION TWO

EXPLORERS STORM CLEAR AS INTER ANATRA STUMBLE

Explorers X1 surged to the top of Division One after a perfect session, claiming two away wins to move onto 13 points. A late Shosuke strike silenced the **Inter Anatra** faithful in a tense 1 - 0 victory, before the leaders swept aside **Isle of Doom** 4 - 1, with Rudanovsky, King Boo (b), Freddie, and Sos Help all on target in gale-force conditions. **Isle of Doom** still climb to second on 10 points, thanks to their earlier 1 - 0 success at **Vulture Street**, where Old Poacher once again proved decisive. The **Allotmenters** stay in the mix, sitting third with 9 points, following a wild 5 - 3 triumph over **Baboon Foxes** before falling narrowly 2 - 1 to Vulture Street. Jens the Snail netted in both fixtures, continuing his fine form. Meanwhile, Inter Anatra endured their first real setback of the campaign - a home defeat to Explorers and a frustrating 0 - 0 draw at **Panglao** sees them slip to fourth on 8 points. Elsewhere, **Hebrides** found their scoring boots with a 5 - 0 hammering of **Mountain High** before a thrilling 3 - 3 draw with **Baboon Foxes**, while **South Sea Rover** finally picked up their first win of the season, beating **Panglao** 3 - 1 before losing 2 - 1 at Mountain High.

ANATRA CITY EDGE CLEAR IN TIGHT TITLE RACE

Anatra City remain top of Division Two after another steady week of results, grinding out a 2 - 1 win away at **Ofah United** after slipping to a narrow 1 - 0 defeat to **FC Costa Diego**. Manager READ's side now sit on 12 points, one clear of their nearest challengers. **FC Costa Diego** continue their strong form, their 1 - 0 home victory over Anatra City courtesy of Limato's second-half strike briefly lifting them to the summit before being held 0 - 0 by **FC Westeros**. They end the session in second with 11 points. **Midnight Wolves** also remain in the title picture, securing a 1 - 0 win over **Barbary**

Coast before sharing the spoils 0 - 0 with **Dross Island**, leaving them third on 10 points. **Blazing Saddles** were left frustrated by back-to-back goalless draws, first at **FC Westeros** and then away to **Isla Teja**, but still hold fourth on 9 points. **Dross Island** delivered the biggest result of the week - a 5 - 0 demolition of **Ofah United** featuring goals from Johnny English (2) and Furst Wank, before a dogged draw with **Midnight Wolves** kept them in fifth with 8 points. At the other end, **Paroot Habashan** found form, drawing 1 - 1 with Isla Teja before beating Barbary Coast 2 - 1, while Ofah United's dismal defensive week saw them lose both matches. **Barbary Coast** remain rooted to the bottom with just a single point.

HOBO AND PHONETIC LOCKED IN EPIC DUEL

Division Three continues to deliver fireworks, with **Hobo Central** and **Phonetic FC** marching on relentlessly - both now boasting 15 points and a +21 goal difference after another dominant set of results that underline their class. **Hobo Central** produced a week of devastating form, demolishing **Burbage Moors** 4 - 0 before dismantling **Hookers Alley** 7 - 1 away from home.

"Dirty" and "Enormous Fred" were again at the heart of the action, while Knickknack Jim and Din Djarin contributed to the rout in the second match. Hobo's attack looks unstoppable, and their defensive discipline has been equally sharp. **Phonetic FC** showed why they share top billing - first edging **Guybrush Threep** 2 - 0 thanks to Carried Away and Baleric, then thrashing **Burbage Moors** 7 - 0 with a brutal attacking display. Pos Ivy and Sierra starred in a performance that oozed dominance and professionalism. Behind the leading pair, **Showaddywaddy** impressed in a thrilling 5 - 3 victory over **Chang Seuk FC**, before being held to a 0 - 0 draw at **Dynamo Mario**. That leaves them on 10 points, tied with **Guybrush Threep**, who drew 1 - 1 at **Chang Seuk** after their earlier defeat. **Real Anatra FC** climbed into fifth with back-to-back wins - 4 - 0 over **Hookers Alley** and 3 - 0 over **Tiggaki Redux** - driven by the inform Ros Berg and Sos Liuka, who continue to inspire their resurgence. Further down the table, **Chang Seuk FC** and **Dynamo Mario** both remain competitive but inconsistent, while **Tiggaki Redux** picked up a valuable 1 - 0 win away at **Dynamo** before faltering against **Real Anatra**. At the bottom, **Hookers Alley's** woes deepened with two more heavy defeats, leaving them pointless and with -25 goal difference.

CUP ROUND 1 REPLAYS

A dramatic night of cup football saw penalty heartbreak, extra-time drama, and one absolute hammering as the final places in the Veterans Cup 2nd Round were confirmed.

Barbary Coast shock Anatra City on penalties (0 - 0, 5 - 4 pens)

Anatra City dominated possession but couldn't find a breakthrough against a disciplined Barbary Coast side who defended bravely in swirling gales. The Coast held firm through extra time and then held their nerve in the shootout, edging it 5 - 4 to book a famous cup upset.

Isle of Doom edge Isla Teja in another shootout (0 - 0, 5 - 3 pens)

In another tense affair, Isle of Doom triumphed in the mud of Isla Teja after 120 goalless minutes. Veteran striker "Old Poacher" netted the decisive penalty as the Doom advance to round two after a gruelling tie.

Vulture Street strike late to beat Mountain High (1 - 0 AET)

An even contest was finally decided deep into extra time when Oos Poutchek struck in the 102nd minute. Vulture Street march on while Mountain High bow out after a brave display.

Hobo Central obliterate weakened Chang Seuk FC (8 - 0)

A remarkable result even by Hobo's standards. The Division 3 leaders tore through a makeshift Chang Seuk XI, with Sos-uacy bagging a hat-trick and Enormous Fred and Dirty also on the scoresheet. Several Chang Seuk fans left early in protest as their side crumbled.

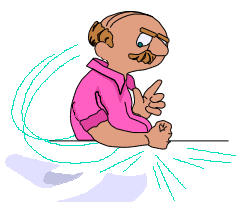

STANDING ORDER PAYMENTS - you can also pay your turn fees by standing order now. Contact us for details about how to do this and remember that this is not only the way to spread your payments over the year rather than having to find a lump sum at the start of every season, but it is also the way to avoid those dreaded double turn fees. With SO payments this can't happen.

MARKING UPDATE



We have worked out a system to check on anybody who is using last season's marking numbers for the current season. Basically the program will save a list of all valid marking successes each session and if somebody cries foul, that he has been marked by somebody who hasn't scouted him, we can check and say yea or nay.

So from now onwards if you use last season's numbers then you will be found out AND if guilty the result of the game will either be reversed or decided against you.

CONTRACTS UPDATE

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **Df/A X 2 / UT/WG/FWS x1.5** / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K+ per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K+

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third+ of his basic wage

so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K+ will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K+

NOTE THIS WELL ALSO

In the calculations above where it refers to WAGES, this also refers to wages + any experience the player as. This means that you are NOT ever sure about the calculation. Not that important for a normal player who does not have an * by his name, but where specialists are involved it can be important. So we suggest that when offering a contract to a player who is a specialist or has an * by his name, you add something extra to the calculation. I would say 5k is a good rule of thumb

MANAGER'S NEEDED

Bringing back the very popular offer we made at start of season.
Take on a new team and you get £100 free credit for it.

You name the league we select the team. Can't beat that can yea!?!?!

STARTING OUT TIPS

If you are lucky you may have a couple of million in the Bank but that won't be enough to turn things around in a couple of sessions. You need to be committed to be in this for the long haul.

?Have a plan. Base your coaching on getting 2 SPS per session. If you get a few more along the way as the season progresses then great either cash them or coach an extra youth player. Aim to coach your APP's & SBY's to level 12's by seasons end. Better to have 3 17/18 yr old level 12's than 5 level 8's.

?Clear out the 24-4's etc. to get them off the wage bill as they will be on relatively high wages. Either sell them to other managers at below NL price (you will still benefit vs selling to NL due to wages). If you can't get a buyer then hold on to them and run their contract down before selling to NL by session 10 _ sales to NL go to half price after that.

?Play 2 APPS or a SBY every game unless you have a realistic chance of winning but try to win your derby games. Keep your MP's for derby games, matches against fellow strugglers and for (hopefully) a bit of a run in the Bowl.

?Build up your cash balance. Keep building this until you have at least circa £8m. Try to pick up bargains (below NL value) from the auction so you can then sell them on at a profit.

?Invest money in youth. Don't rely on this producing multiple MF specialists, unless your name is Morten. What you will hopefully get is a few FUT's which you can coach at 0.5 SP per level or sell for cash. This is a good way of increasing your teams' skill level quickly.

?Choose a category for the team and aim to get all the players of the same category (P, S or P/S). Having a power team is easier to build up quickly as there are more of them, there are plenty of 95 BW's around and are cheap to buy. However, longer term you will need to change the category of them team as power teams don't become super teams.

?If you have players that don't match your chosen category look to trade them for another player who is. It is rare your team will be full of P/S players so if you have any it may be best to move them on to build up your cash balance or trade for another player.

?Look to get a good quality GK and SW. You may not win many matches but two level 12's at the back could bring in some extra SP's through 0-0 draws.

?Don't coach anyone over the age of 18 unless there is a really good reason to do so e.g. 23-10 MF specialist.

?You need a captain so you can afford one player over the age of 19 _ hopefully your captain will star or get rejuvenated.

?Within 2 seasons you should have a team full of level 12's and a decent cash balance as a solid platform to start your ascent to being the next KA super team.
